Subject: Implementation of Terminal Aerodrome Forecast (TAF) Service for
Gogebic Iron County Airport, MI: Effective October 12, 2011

Note: The following changes have no impact on NOAA Weather Wire Service
subscribers.

Effective Wednesday, October 12, 2011, at 0000 Coordinated Universal Time
(UTC), the NWS office at Marquette, MI, will begin TAF service for Gogebic
Iron County Airport (KIWD) in Ironwood, Michigan. After that date,
routine and updated TAFs will be issued for this airport 24 hours a day.

NWS personnel/offices will need to add the following identifier to their
communications systems to receive the new TAF:
