(MTW) in Manitowoc, WI, Effective: February 25, 2014

The following changes have no impact on NOAA Weather  
Wire Service subscribers

Corrected to change effective time to 1800 Universal  
Coordinated Time (UTC) on the same day, February 25, 2014.

Effective Tuesday, February 25, 2014, at 0000 Universal  
Coordinated Time (UTC), the NWS office at Green Bay, WI, will  
begin TAF service for a new site. After that date, routine and  
updated TAFs will be issued for these airports 24 hours a day.

NWS personnel/offices will need to add the following identifier  
to their communications systems to receive the new TAFs:
