Subject: Implementation of Terminal Aerodrome Forecast (TAF) Service for
EAR, Kearney Regional Airport, Kearney, NE: Effective: July 1, 2014

Effective Tuesday, July 1, 2014, at 0000 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC),
the NWS office at Hastings, NE, will begin TAF service for Kearney
Regional Airport in Kearney, NE. After that date, NWS will issue routine
and updated TAFs for this airport 24 hours a day.

NWS personnel/offices will need to add the following identifier to their
communications systems to receive the new TAF:
