Subject: Implementation of Terminal Aerodrome Forecast (TAF) service for  
Klawock, Alaska (PAKW): Effective June 1, 2015

Note: The following changes have no impact on NOAA Weather Wire Service  
subscribers.

Effective June 1, 2015 at 1800 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), the NWS  
Office in Juneau, AK, will begin TAF service for the Klawock, AK, Airport  
(PAKW). Routine and updated TAFs will be issued for this airport, 24  
hours a day.

NWS personnel will need to add the following identifier to their  
communications systems to receive the new TAF:
