



OVERVIEW

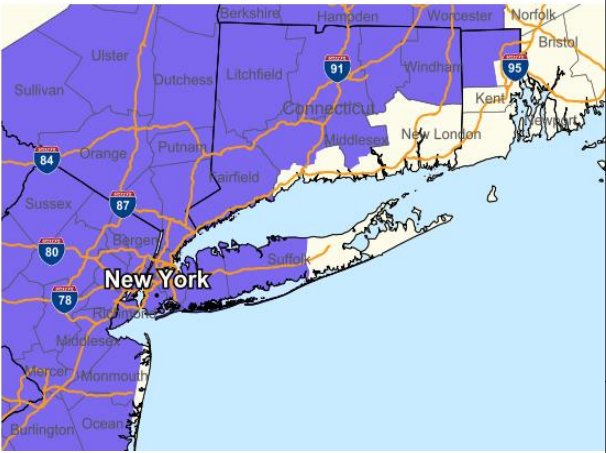
- A weak frontal system will bring the chance of light freezing rain early this morning before changing to rain by late morning.
- Confidence is increasing in an accumulating snowfall for the region Thursday Night into Friday.

THIS MORNING

- **Ice Accumulation This Morning:** A few hundredths of an inch of ice expected across NE NJ, and much of the Lower Hudson Valley and Interior CT. Trace ice accumulations are possible for NYC, Nassau, S Westchester and S Fairfield. All rain for E LI and SE CT.
- **Timing** – Through mid-late morning, transitioning to all rain from coast to Interior.
- **Impacts** – With preceding cold surface temps, this event may result in icing on untreated and elevated surfaces, and dangerous travel.

Winter Weather Advisory in effect for freezing rain through late this morning.

THURSDAY NIGHT INTO FRIDAY MORNING

- **Accumulating Snowfall Potential Thu Night into Fri:** Moderate to high potential for 2" or more of snow accum, with a low potential for 6" or more of snow accum for the entire area.
- **Impacts** - This will result in snow covered roads and hazardous travel, especially for the Friday morning commute.

NWS ALERTS

- **Winter Weather Advisory:** NE NJ and much of Lower Hudson Valley and Interior CT through midday, NYC, and western Long Island until 10 AM

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Quite a bit of weather model spread in the track of low pressure for Thursday Night into Friday. A weaker and/or farther offshore low would result in light snow accum, with a stronger and/or closer to the coast track increasing the potential for warning level snowfall.

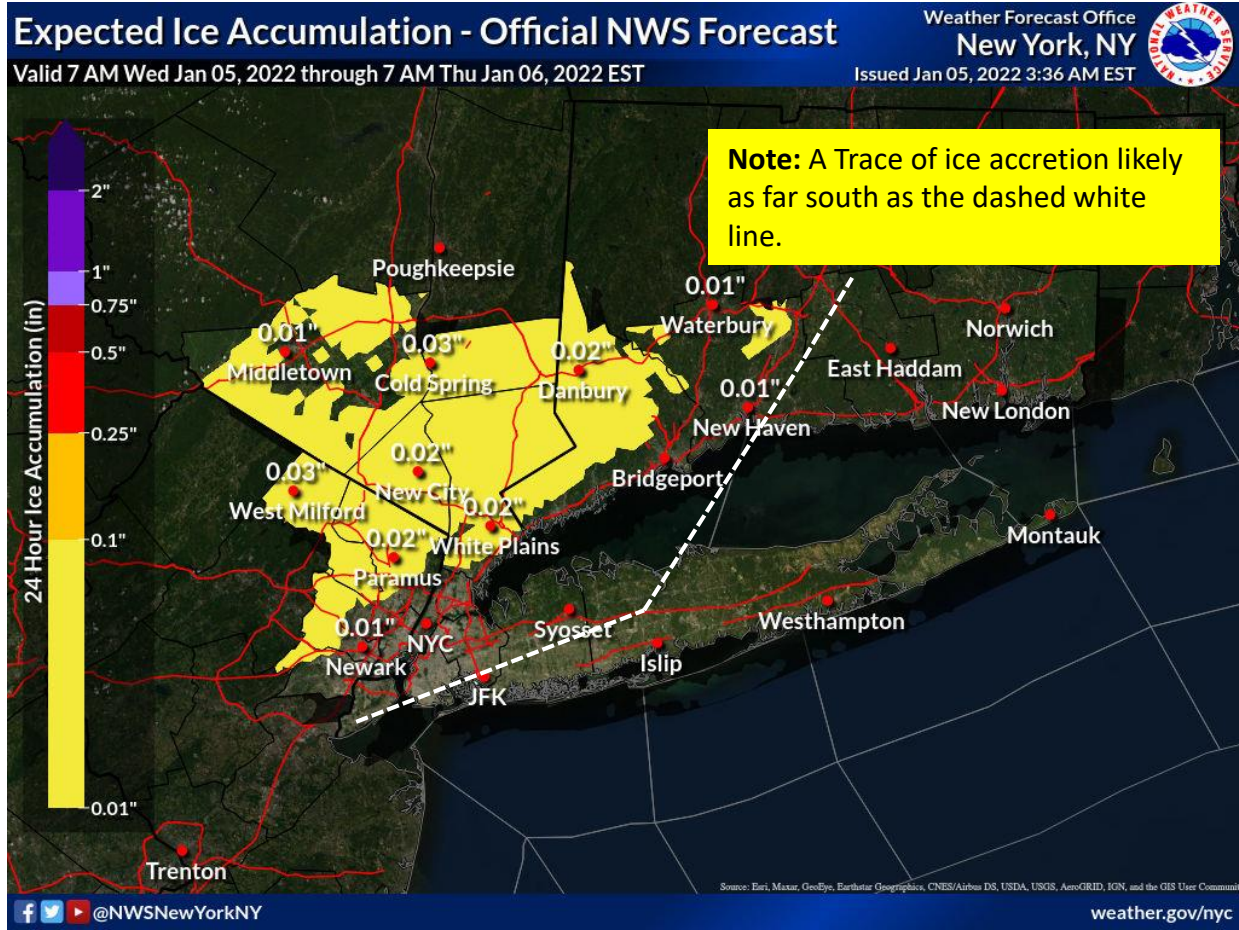

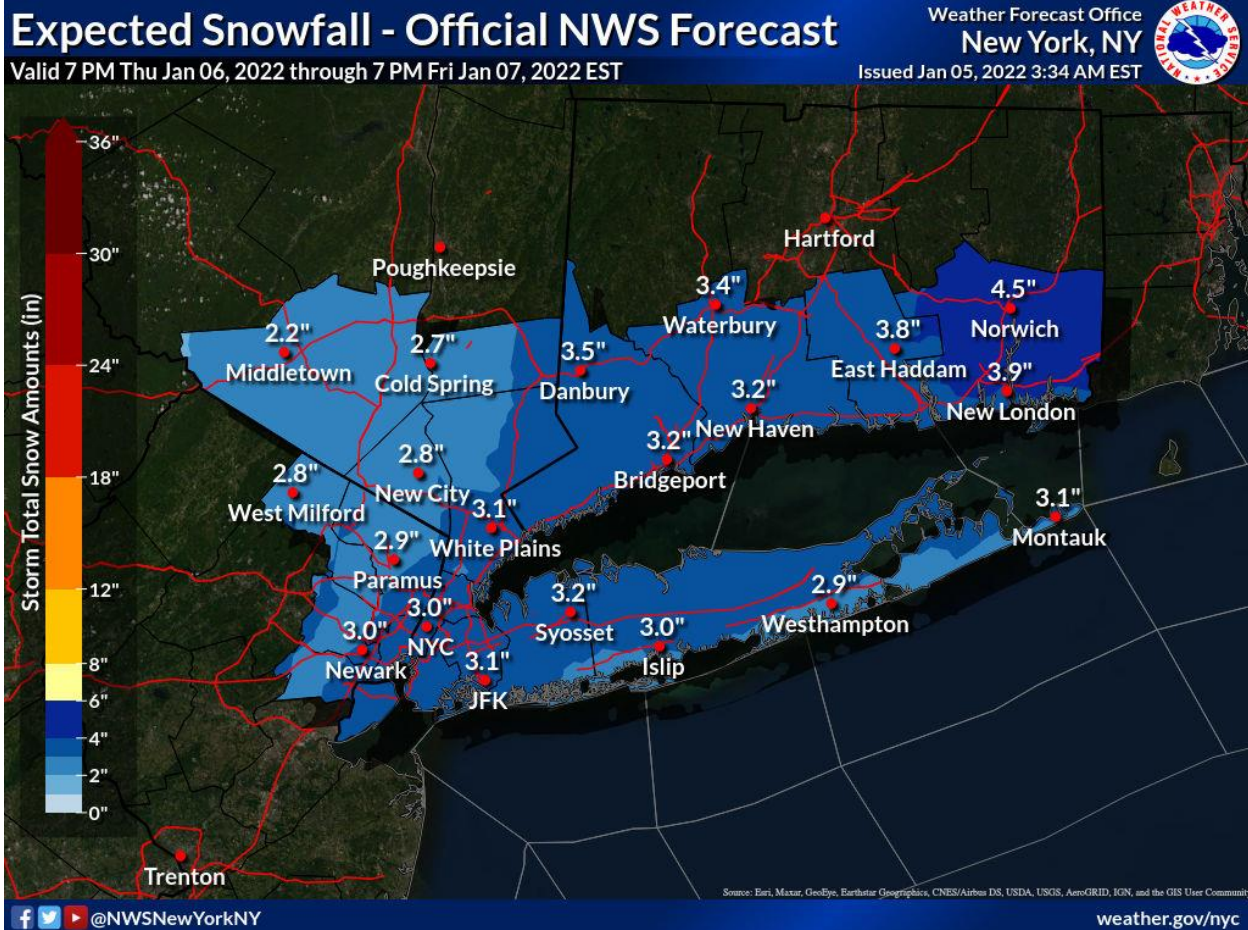

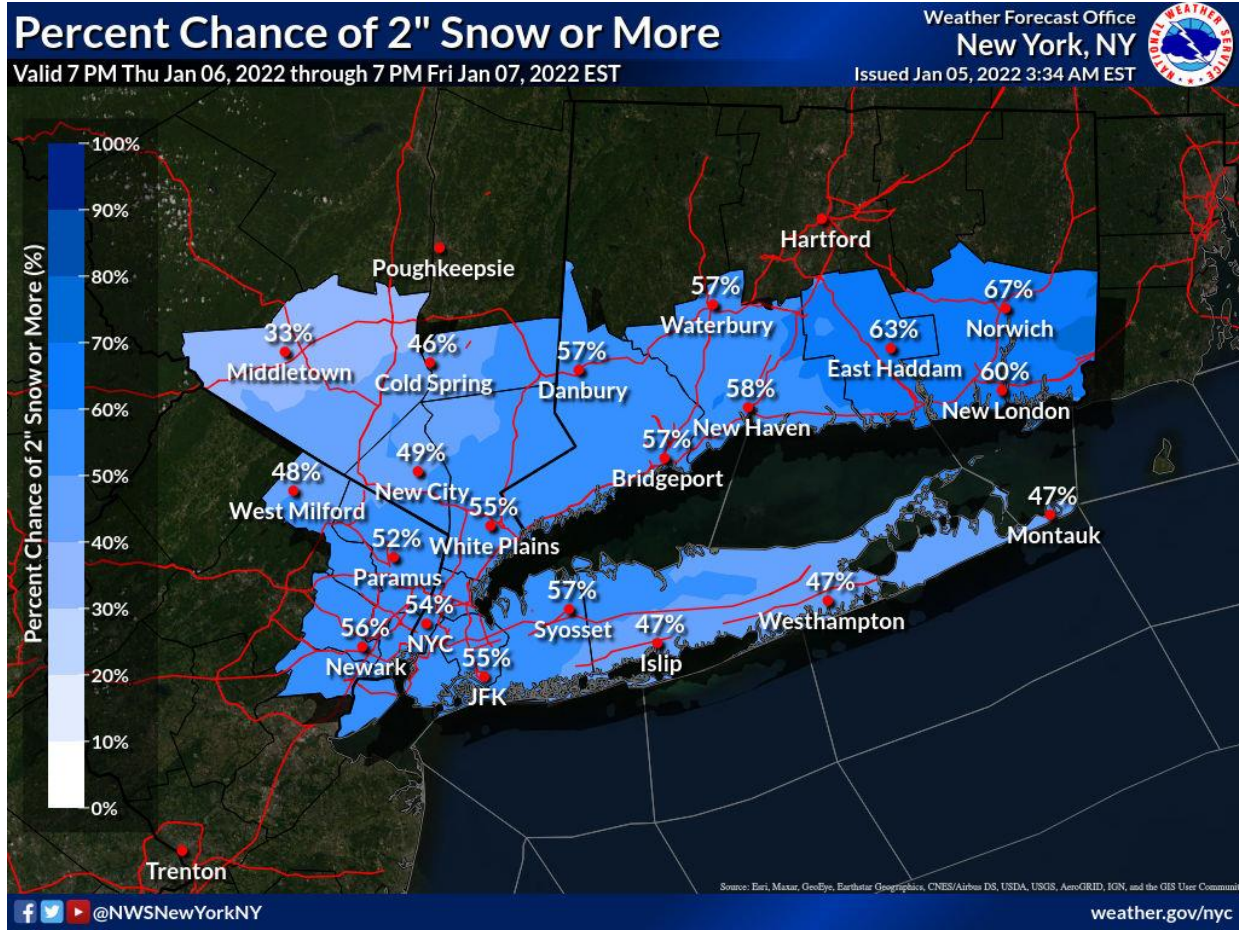

Probability of 2" Snow or More for Thu Night into Friday



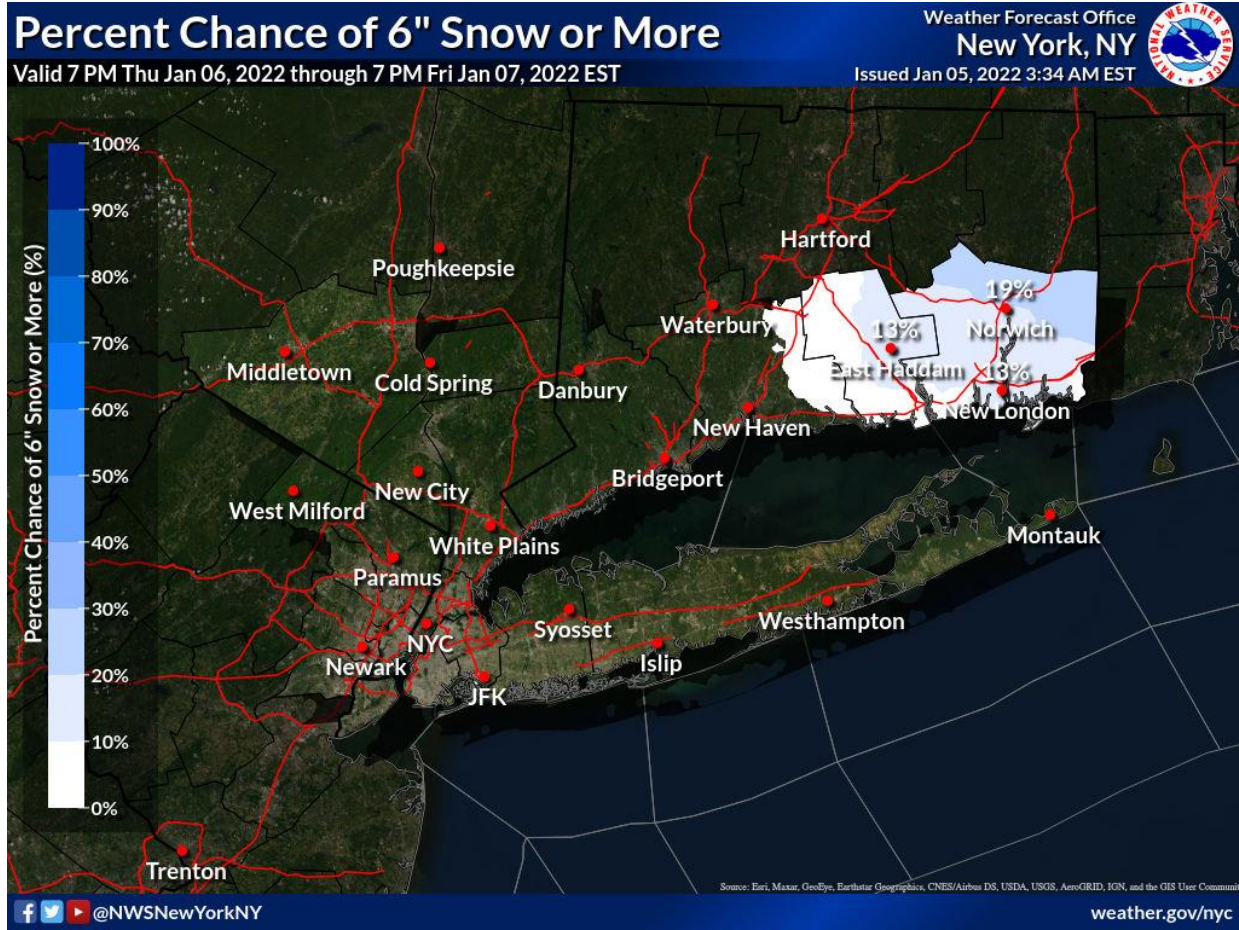
