OVERVIEW

An Arctic airmass will affect the region Monday into Wednesday.







Frigid Temperatures:

- Lows in the single digits/lower teens Mon Night and Tue Night.
- Highs only in the teens to near 20 deg F on Tue.
- Temperatures will likely be 20 deg F or lower Monday Night through Wednesday morning.
- Impacts Threat for poorly insulated water pipes to freeze and burst.

Sub Zero Wind Chills Monday Night into Tuesday:

- Wind chills as low as 0 to 10 degrees below zero Mon Night into Tue Morning.
- Impacts- Hypothermia and frostbite with prolonged exposure.



Low Temperature from 01/09/2022 6PM to 01/10/2022 6AM Valid: January 10, 2022




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Maximum Temperature Forecast Monday








Minimum Temperature Forecast Mon Night into Tue AM

Coldest Wind Chill Temperatures for the Beginning of the Week Valid: Mon - Tue









Heating Fire Safety



Follow these heating tips to help maintain a fire-safe home this winter.



Space Heater

- Neep anything that can burn, such as bedding, clothing and curtains, at least 3 feet
- Make sure the heater has an automatic shut-off, so if it tips over, it shuts off.
- > Turn heaters off when you go to bed or leave the room.
- Plug portable heaters directly into outlets and never into an extension cord or
- Only use portable heaters from a recognized testing laboratory.



Fireplace

- Keep a glass or metal screen in front of the fireplace to prevent embers or sparks
- Do not burn paper in your fireplace.
- Dut the fire out before you go to sleep or leave your home.
- Dut ashes in a metal container with a lid, outside, at least 10 feet from your home.



Wood Stove

- Make sure your wood stove is 3 feet from anything that can burn.
- Do not burn paper in your wood stove.
- Dut the fire out before you go to sleep or leave your home.
- Have your chimney inspected and cleaned each year by a professional.



Furnace

- Have your furnace inspected each year.
- Keep anything that can burn away from the furnace.




Kerosene Heater

- Only use kerosene heaters from a recognized testing laboratory.
- Make sure the heater has an automatic shut-off, so if it tips over, it shuts off.
- Refuel your cooled heater outside.
