Two Rounds of Rainfall Through Thursday

Overview

- A couple of low pressure systems will bring periods of rain through Thursday, with the second system producing moderate to heavy rainfall.
- Widespread minor urban, poor drainage flooding is possible Wednesday night into Thursday. Minor flooding will also be possible along several guick responding small rivers, streams, and creeks.



Tuesday - Rain : 1/2" to 3/4" area wide

Wed into Wed Night - Heavy Rain: 1 to 2.5" likely, locally 3" possible east of NYC.

- Rainfall Rates: 1/4" to 1/2" per hour at times late Wednesday & Wednesday night.
- Urban/Poor Drainage Flooding: The threat of flash flooding is low and localized for urban, poor drainage, and low-lying areas.
- River/Stream Flooding: Minor flooding possible Wednesday night into Thursday along several quick responding small rivers, streams, creeks and adjacent roads and properties. Moderate flooding possible along a few quick responding small rivers, streams, creeks and adjacent roads and properties if rainfall exceeds 3" in 12 hrs. Significant rises are possible for large stem rivers as well through the mid to late week period.

Sat into Sun Outlook: Potential for an additional 1 to 1.5" of rain. Additional widespread urban, poor drainage, and river flooding impacts are possible.

& IMPACTS

• Flood Watch: None currently in effect.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Increasing clarity expected over the next 24 hrs. on rainfall rates and location, and magnitude of the heavy rain axis for the Wed-Thu evening as it becomes resolved by high-resolution guidance. Uncertainty remains on the duration of any heavier rain.
- Soil moisture is running 40-80% above normal, with a majority of area rivers and streamflows running above to much above normal. This would allow for more rainfall than usual to turn more quickly into runoff and flooding. Each successive rain event will further elevate soil moisture and stream flows, increasing the urban and river flood threat.




Valid Wednesday Into Wednesday Night

Significant River Flood Outlook



Minor flooding likely along several quick responding small rivers and streams across NE NJ, Lower Hud, and S CT Wed aft into Thu.

- ✓ Moderate flooding possible along a few quick responding small rivers and streams, including the Saddle, Ramapo and Passaic Rivers in NE NJ, if greater than 3" of rainfall is realized Wed into Wed Night.
- ✓ Moderate Flood Impacts: Some inundation of structures and roads near stream, evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations.

Forecast Challenge: There will be increasing clarity on the breath and magnitude of river flooding ahead as each event draws closer.
