

### **Another Round of Moderate to Heavy Rainfall**

Wednesday PM through Early Thursday AM

#### **Overview**

- A coastal low will bring moderate to heavy rain Wed PM through Thu AM
- Widespread minor urban, poor drainage flooding is likely Wed night into Thu. Minor flooding is also be possible along several guick responding small rivers, streams, and creeks.

### Flood Watches Warnings and Advisories



Wed PM into Thu AM Heavy Rain:

- Storm Total Rainfall:
- LI and S CT: 2 to 3" likely, locally higher possible.
- NYC/NJ metro, NE NJ, and Lower Hud: 1 to 2" likely, locally higher possible.
- Peak Rainfall Rates: Around 1"/ hr at times Wed 6pm to 3am Thurs
- Urban/Poor Drainage Flooding: Widespread minor flooding of urban, poor drainage, and lowlying areas. The threat of flash flooding is localized.
- River/Stream Flooding: Minor flooding likely Wed night into Thursday along a few to several quick responding small rivers, streams, creeks and adjacent roads and properties, particularly across S CT. Moderate flooding possible along a few quick responding small rivers, streams, creeks and adjacent roads and properties if rainfall exceeds 3" in 12 hrs. Primary threat across S CT. Significant rises are possible for large stem rivers of CT as well through the late week period.

**Sat into Sun Outlook:** Potential for an additional 1 to 2" of rain. Additional widespread urban, poor drainage, and river flooding impacts are possible. Minor coastal flooding possible during the times of high tide Thu Night into the weekend.

• Flood Watch: For much of the region

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Exact location of a 30-50 mile wide axis of heavy rainfall. Higher probability for this to setup across E LI and S CT, with decreasing probability farther west.
- Soil moisture is running 60-80% above normal, with a majority of area rivers and streamflows running above to much above normal. This will allow for rainfall to more quickly become runoff and flooding. Each successive rain event will further elevate soil moisture and stream flows, increasing the urban and river flood threat.






### **Storm Total Rainfall**



# River Flooding Outlook





Minor flooding likely along several quick responding small rivers and streams, especially across S CT Wed PM into Thu.

- ✓ Moderate flooding possible along a few quick responding small rivers and streams, including the Yantic River if greater than 3" of rainfall is realized Wed into Wed Night.
- ✓ Moderate Flood Impacts: Some inundation of structures and roads near stream, evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations.

**Forecast Challenge:** The exact axis of heavy rainfall will determine the breadth and magnitude of river flooding.


# Southern CT River Flooding Potential

- ✓ Minor flooding likely along several quick responding small rivers and streams if greater than 2" of rainfall is realized.
- ✓ Moderate flooding possible along a few quick responding small rivers and streams if greater than 3" of rain is realized, including the Yantic River.
- ✓ Moderate Flood Impacts: Some inundation of structures and roads near stream, evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations.


### Northeastern NJ River Flooding Potential

- ✓ Minor flooding likely along several quick responding small rivers and streams, including the Saddle River, Ramapo River, Rahway, Passaic, Hackensack Rivers and Hohokus Brook if greater than 1 ½ to 2" of rain is realized.
- ✓ Moderate flooding possible along a few quick responding small rivers and streams if greater than 2 ½ to 3" of rain is realized, particularly the Saddle River.
- ✓ Moderate Flood Impacts: Some inundation of structures and roads near stream, evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations.
