## Overview

- High pressure over the Southeast and low pressure over the Canadian Maritimes will combine to produce strong winds late tonight and through Monday evening.

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### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

#### Strong Winds

- **Peak Winds:** NW 25-35 mph with gusts to 55 mph. Isolated gusts to 60 mph possible, especially for the higher elevations.
- **Timing:** Late tonight through Monday evening.
- **Impacts:** Strong winds could blow down tree limbs and blow around unsecured objects. A few trees and power lines could be downed. Travel may be difficult, especially for high profile vehicles.

### NWS ALERTS

- **Wind Advisory:** Entire area.
- **Gale Warning:** All waters.

### OTHER INFORMATION

- Before peak winds arrive daytime Monday, wind gusts to around 40 mph are expected tonight, especially after midnight. The strongest winds will be near the coast.
- Some residual river flooding is possible into early this evening.
