
Heat Continues into Early Next Week; Localized Flash Flooding Fri



OVERVIEW

- Heat Advisory remains in effect through Friday evening as maximum heat index values range from the mid 90s to around 100 Friday.
- Maximum heat index values in the low 90s on Saturday before possibly increasing again into the middle and upper 90s Sunday into early next week.
- Showers and thunderstorms Friday afternoon and evening may produce localized flash flooding.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS



Heat – Max heat indices of 95 to around 100 on Friday. Some minor relief is possible on Saturday with highs in the middle to upper 80s and max heat indices in the lower 90s. Higher heat returns Sunday into early next week with max heat indices of 95 to 100 possible.

Impacts – There is an increased risk of heat-related illness for vulnerable populations with this event.

Flash Flood Risk – Showers and thunderstorms Friday afternoon into Friday night could bring localized flash flooding due to a weak steering flow and tropical moisture. The localized risk of flash flooding may continue on Saturday as additional showers and thunderstorms are possible.

- A Heat Advisory remains in effect through 8 pm Friday.
- Additional heat advisories may be needed Sunday into early next week.

By 6pm Friday, unless there are significant changes.
