## Heat Continues into Early Next Week...



## **OVERVIEW**

- The heat advisory remains in effect through 8pm this evening. No additional heat headlines for Saturday.
- Maximum heat index values in the low to mid 90s on Saturday before increasing again into the upper 90s to low 100s Sunday into early next week. Additional heat headlines may be needed.
- Ongoing showers and thunderstorms this evening may produce localized flash flooding, especially north and west of NYC.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

**Heat** –Continued hot and humid on Saturday with highs in the middle to upper 80s and max heat indices in the lower 90s. Higher heat returns Sunday and Monday with max heat indices of 95 to 100. Cooler weather returns on Tuesday.

**Impacts** – There remains an increased risk of heat-related illness for vulnerable populations with this event.

**Flash Flood Risk** – Showers and thunderstorms this evening may result in localized flash flooding. This is most likely north and west of NYC, where activity is currently ongoing. The localized risk of flash flooding may continue on Saturday as additional showers and thunderstorms are possible in the afternoon.






