High Heat and Humidity Continues Through at Least Monday...



OVFRVIFW

- A Bermuda high will remain offshore through early in the week, continuing to provide very warm, humid conditions.
- A heat advisory is now in effect through 8 pm Monday.
- There remains an a localized threat of flash flooding with any storms, especially north and west of NYC for early this evening, and again for Sunday afternoon and early Sunday evening.



Heat - Maximum heat index values will range mainly 95 to 100 on Sunday afternoon, with lower and middle 90s across eastern coastal sections. Values will then increase slightly into the upper 90s to lower 100s on Monday afternoon in most places, with mainly middle 90s (and a few upper 90s) across eastern coastal sections.

Temperatures at night will remain elevated and will not allow for much cooling. Nighttime lows in most non-urban areas will be in the middle 70s, to around 80 in the NYC and NE NJ metro.

These conditions could potentially linger into Tuesday, until a cold front breaks the heat mid week.


Impacts – There remains an increased risk of heat-related illness for vulnerable populations with this event.

Flash Flood Risk – Scattered showers and thunderstorms this evening may result in localized flash flooding, mainly north and west of NYC. The localized risk of flash flooding continues on Sunday as additional scattered showers and thunderstorms are possible in the afternoon and early evening.


- A Heat Advisory is in effect through 8 pm Monday for the afternoon and early evening hours.
