



Multiple Rounds of Mainly Minor Coastal Flooding

Key Messages

- Minor to localized moderate coastal flooding expected through Thursday night.
- There is the potential for additional rounds of coastal flooding through the weekend.
- Dangerous rip currents through the weekend.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- **Coastal Flood** – Minor to localized moderate coastal flooding with 1 to possibly 2 ft. of inundation for vulnerable coastal locales along the south shore bays of Nassau and Queens, Lower NY/NJ Harbor, and locations adjacent to western LI Sound.
 - **Oceanfront** – A building easterly swell through this weekend will produce surf up to 6 ft. This will result in dangerous rip currents and minor beach erosion.
- Timing and Location:**
- Minor to localized moderate coastal flood impacts through Thursday night during times of high tide.
 - Dangerous Rip Currents at ocean beaches through the weekend.

NWS ALERTS

- **Coastal Flood Statements in effect for eastern LI and coastal New Haven county CT.**

OUTLOOK

- Dangerous rip currents are likely through the weekend.
- Minor to localized moderate coastal flood impacts possible through the weekend.
