OVERVIEW

- Strong to damaging wind gusts are expected tonight through Wednesday afternoon as a strong offshore low pressure system makes its closest approach.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Peak Winds In Warning Areas:** N 35-45 mph with gusts to 65 mph
- Peak Winds In Advisory Areas:** N 20-30 mph with gusts to 55 mph
- Impacts:** Strong to damaging winds will blow down tree limbs and blow around unsecured objects. Scattered trees and power lines could be downed, particularly across the warning areas. Power outages are possible. Travel will be difficult, especially for high profile vehicles.

TIMING & LOCATION

- Tonight through Wednesday afternoon.

- Wind Advisory:** Western Suffolk, Nassau, Northern New London, Middlesex, Southern New Haven and Southern Fairfield.
- High Wind Warning:** Eastern Suffolk and southern New London.

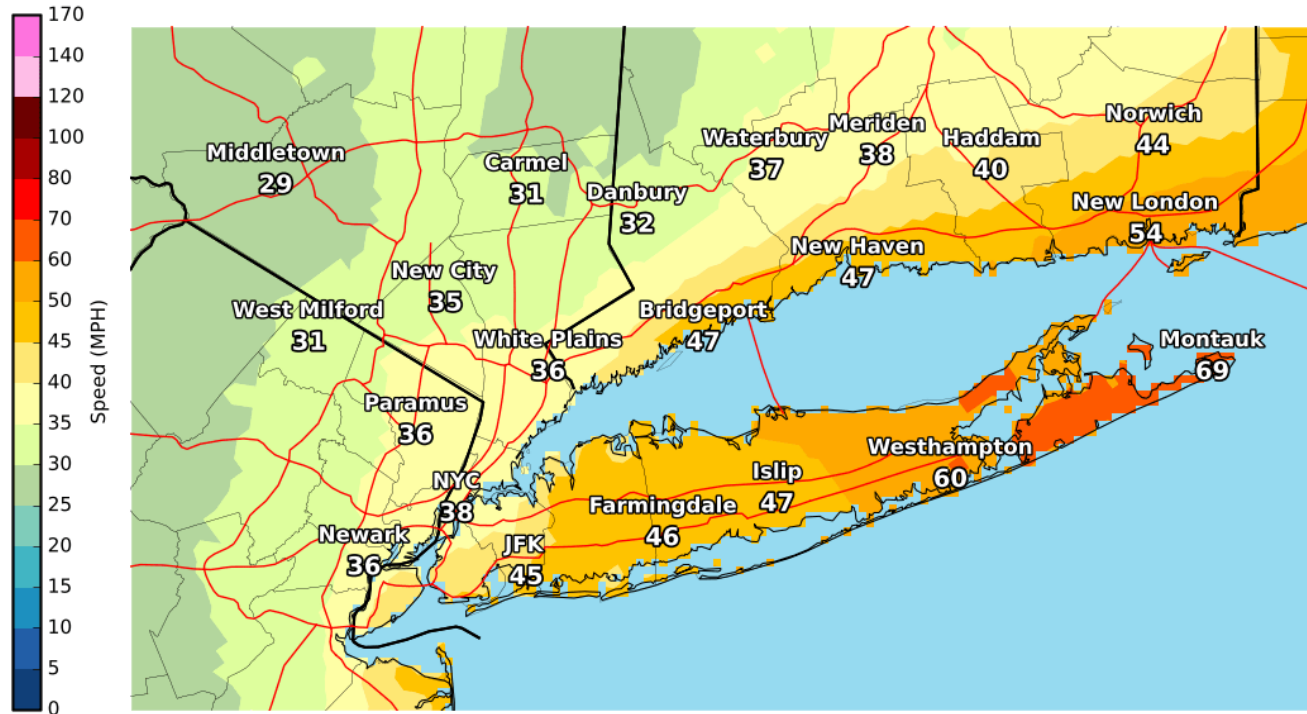
