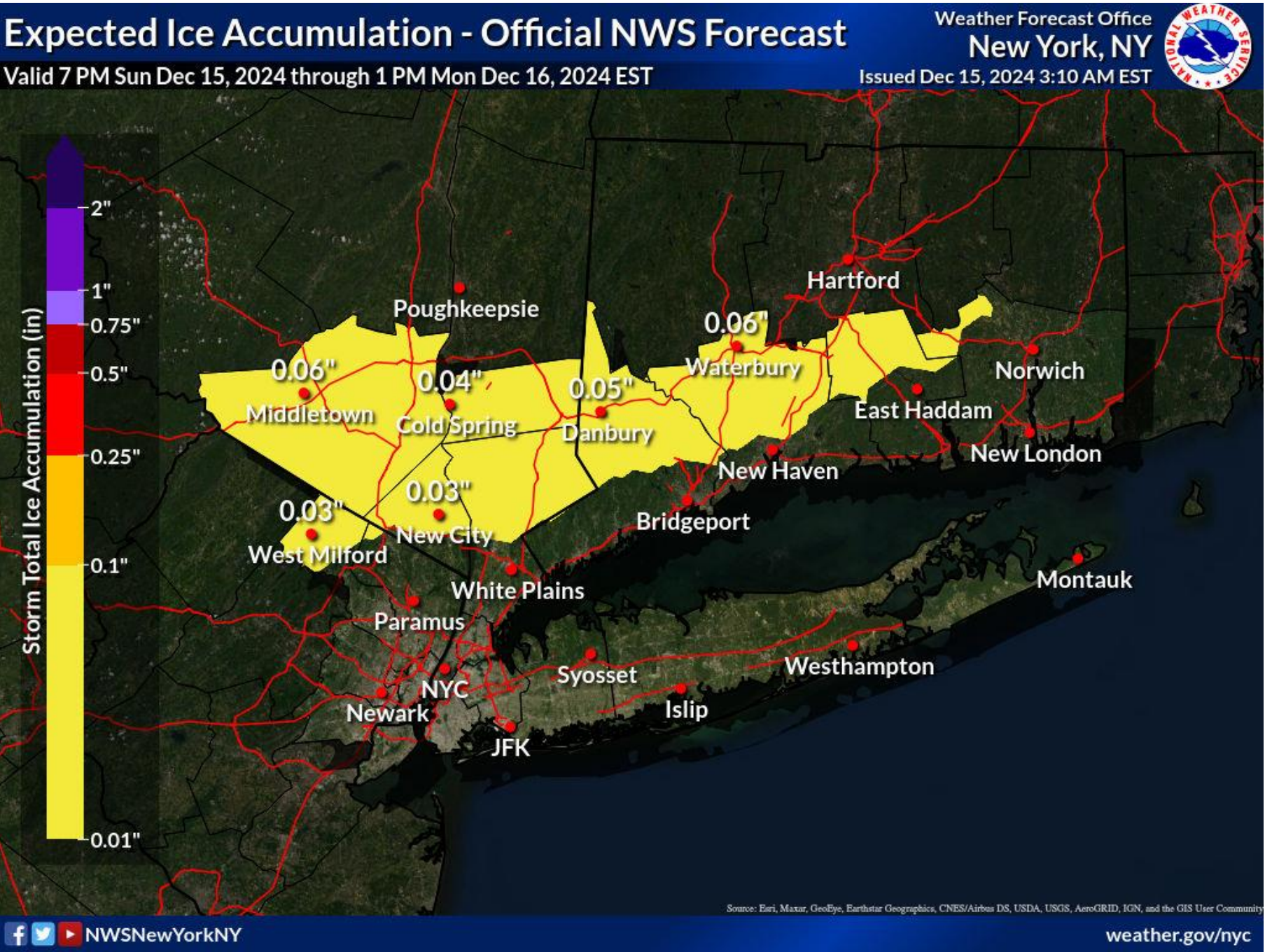

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	■ Impacts: Icy travel conditions, especially on untreated and elevated surfaces, during the morning commute in the Advisory area. ■ Ice Accumulation: A glaze to several hundredths of an inch late tonight into the Monday morning commute ■ Snow Accumulation: Generally under an inch with portions of western Orange County around an inch. ■ Timing: Light snow may begin late this evening across portions of the Lower Hudson Valley and NE NJ and spread east into SW CT overnight. The snow changes to freezing rain early Monday morning, becoming plain rain by mid morning.
NWS ALERTS	■ Winter Weather Advisory: Western Passaic, Orange, Rockland, Putnam, Northern Westchester 10 pm Sunday to 11 am Monday. Northern Fairfield, Northern New Haven and Northern Middlesex 1 am to 11 am Monday.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	■ The exact timing of the transition to freezing rain. ■ How long it will take for ground temperatures to rise above freezing. ■ The Advisory may need to be expanded into Northern New London County.
