

First Wintry Precipitation of the Season Tuesday Night



OVERVIEW

- A quick moving coastal low will bring light snow and ice across the interior late today into tonight.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Total Snowfall:** Up to 2” across northern and western Orange County tonight. Less than an inch across the remainder of the Lower Hudson Valley, interior NE NJ and inland S CT. This could result in slippery road conditions overnight, and possibly the morning commute.
- Ice Accumulation:** A light glaze of ice across northern and western Orange County. Conditions will be slippery on any untreated and elevated surfaces which could impact overnight travel, and possibly the morning commute.
- Temperatures:** Around freezing to the lower 30s tonight into early Wednesday morning. Temperatures rise to above freezing everywhere around 7 am Wednesday morning.

- Winter Weather Advisory** : Orange County

FORECAST CHALLENGES

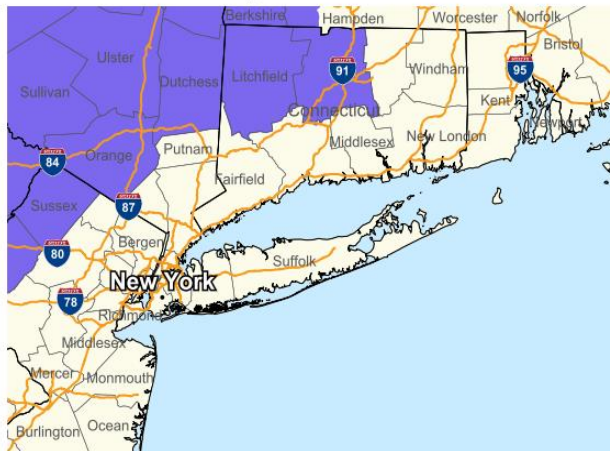
- Wintry precipitation may move in as early as late this afternoon, but generally after 7 pm. A changeover to plain rain will occur through the night but possibly as late as 7 am Wednesday for Orange County.
- A track farther inland would result in less snow and ice, while a track farther offshore could result in slightly higher amounts.

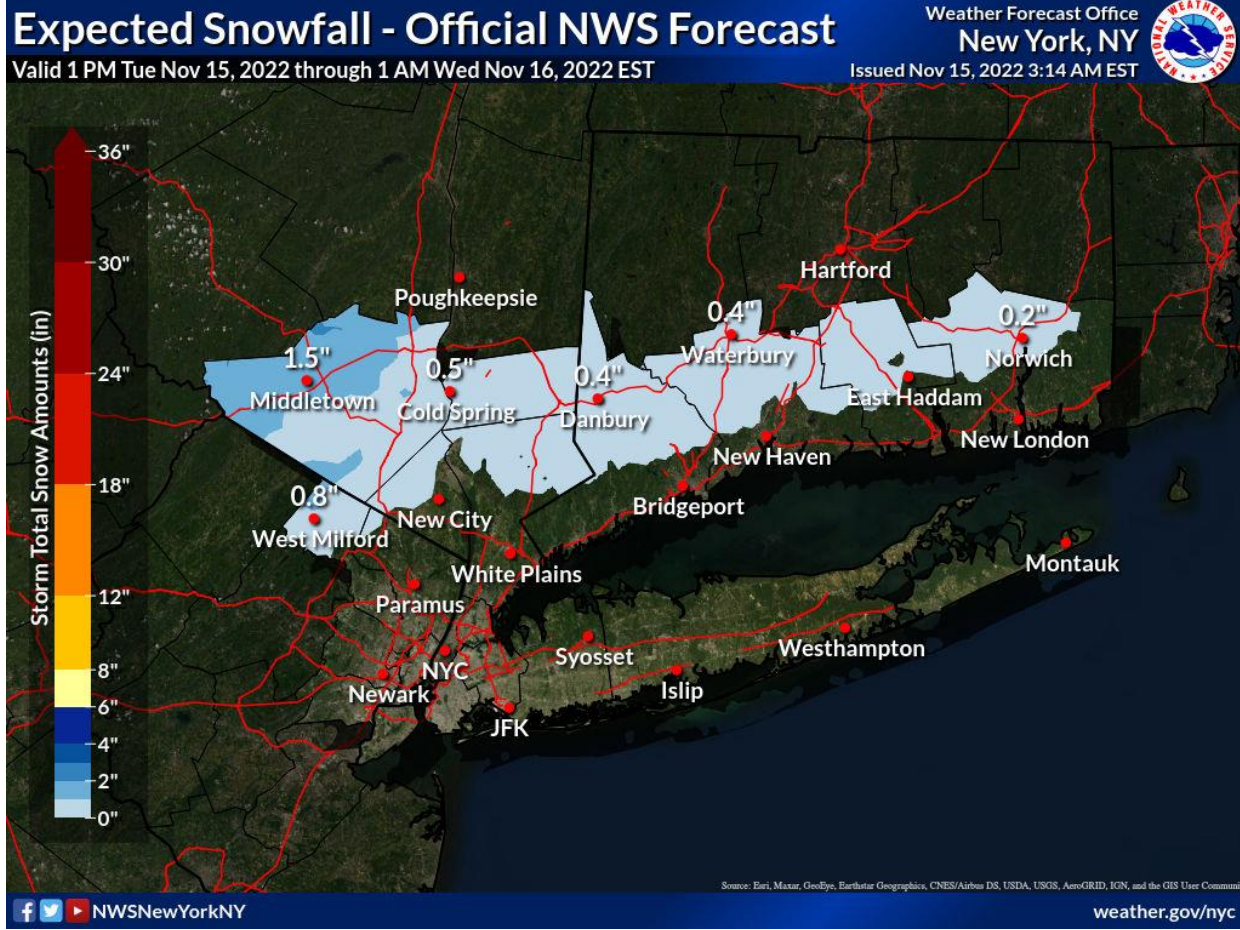

Most Likely Snowfall Accumulation – Official Forecast



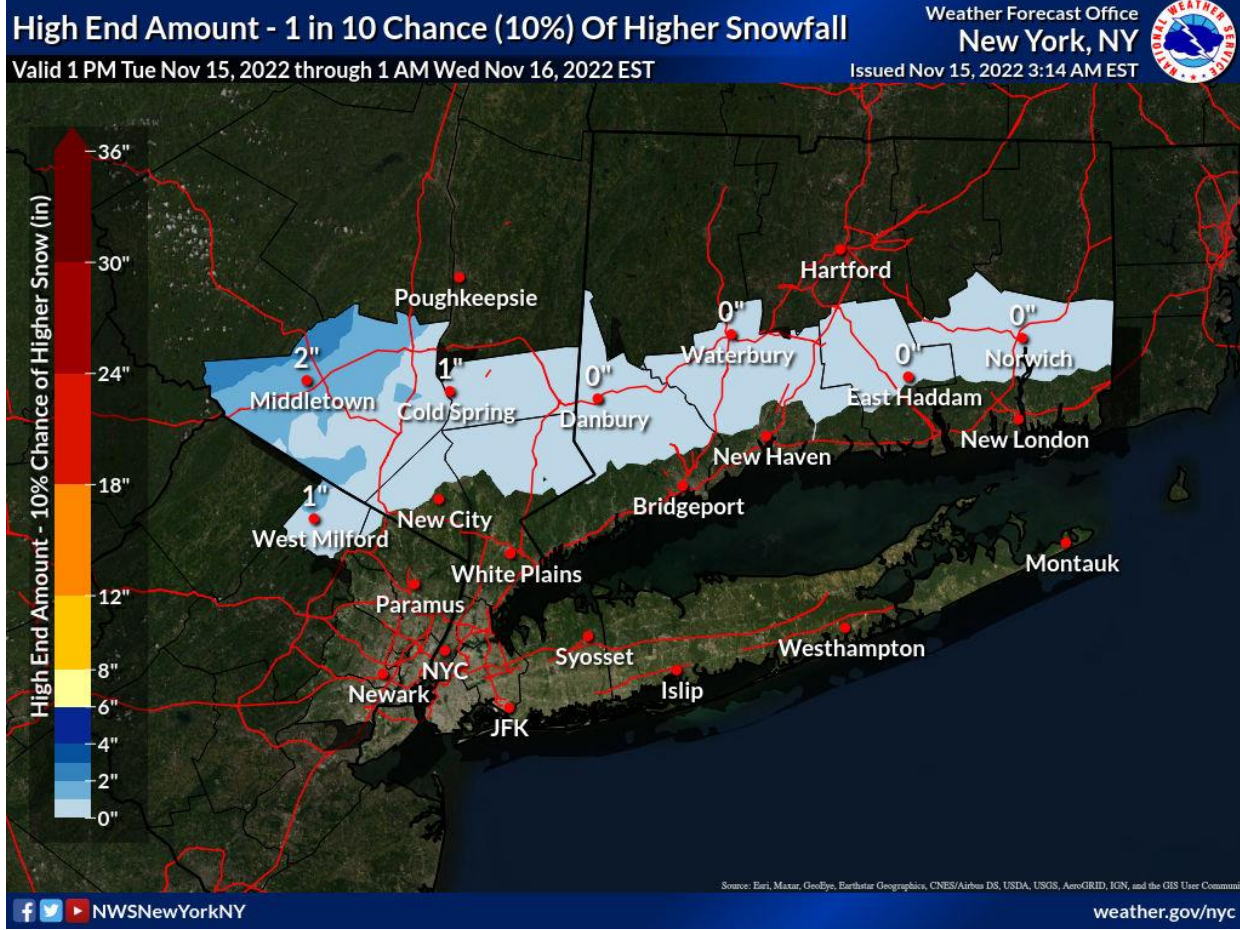

Probabilistic Snowfall Accumulation – High End Amount (1 in 10 chance of higher)



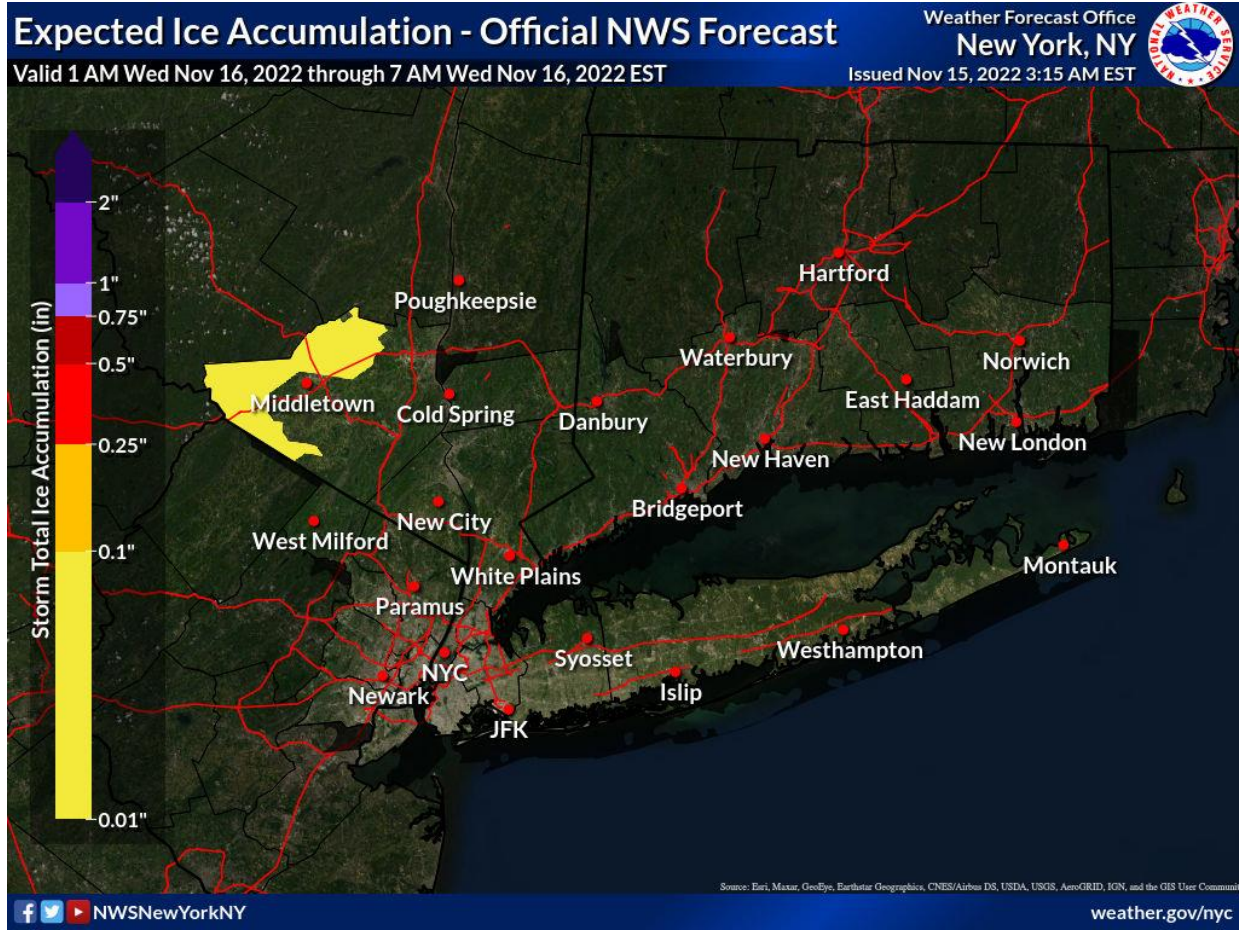
