

Strong Winds Likely Wednesday Afternoon Into Wednesday Evening

OVERVIEW

- Strong wind gusts and brief heavy downpours are likely with the of the passage of a cold front Wednesday afternoon into Wednesday evening.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Peak Wind Gusts:** 35 to 45 mph likely, with potential for a period of 45 to 55 mph wind gusts Wednesday afternoon into Wednesday evening.
- Impacts:** Winds could down tree limbs and damage unsecured objects. A few power lines could be downed as well. While flooding is not expected, brief heavy downpours could still impact the evening rush.

TIMING & LOCATION

- Approximately 11 am to 9 pm from west to east across the entire local Tri-State area.

NWS ALERTS

- Wind Advisory** for Long Island and southern Connecticut late Wed Morning into Wed Evening.
- Gale Warning** for all waters Wed afternoon into Wed Night.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Although there is higher confidence of the strongest gusts occurring mainly east of NYC, there is still a least a low chance of gusts 45 to 55 mph elsewhere, particularly right ahead and behind the passage of the cold front.

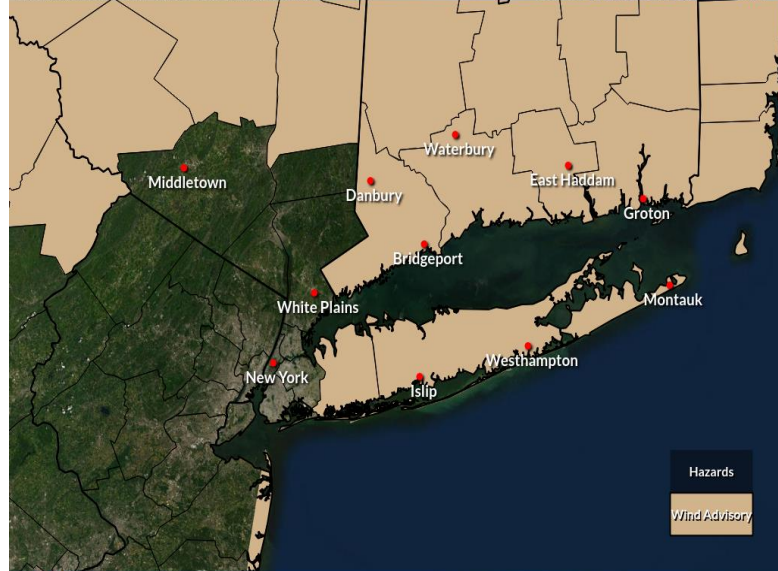
