

Strong Winds Likely This Afternoon Into This Evening

OVERVIEW

- Strong wind gusts and brief heavy downpours are likely with the passage of a cold front this afternoon into this evening.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Peak Wind Gusts:** 45 to 55 mph wind gusts this afternoon into this evening in the advisory areas and 35 to 45 mph elsewhere.
- Impacts:** Winds could down tree limbs and damage unsecured objects. A few power lines could be downed as well. While flooding is not expected, brief heavy downpours could still impact the evening rush.

TIMING & LOCATION

- Approximately 11 am to 9 pm from west to east across the entire local Tri-State area.

NWS ALERTS

- Wind Advisory** : late this morning into this evening for Long Island, southern Connecticut, and Queens and Brooklyn in NYC.
- Gale Warning** for all waters this afternoon into tonight.

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Although there is higher confidence of the strongest gusts occurring the advisory areas, there is still a least a low chance of gusts 45 to 55 mph elsewhere, particularly right ahead and behind the passage of the cold front.

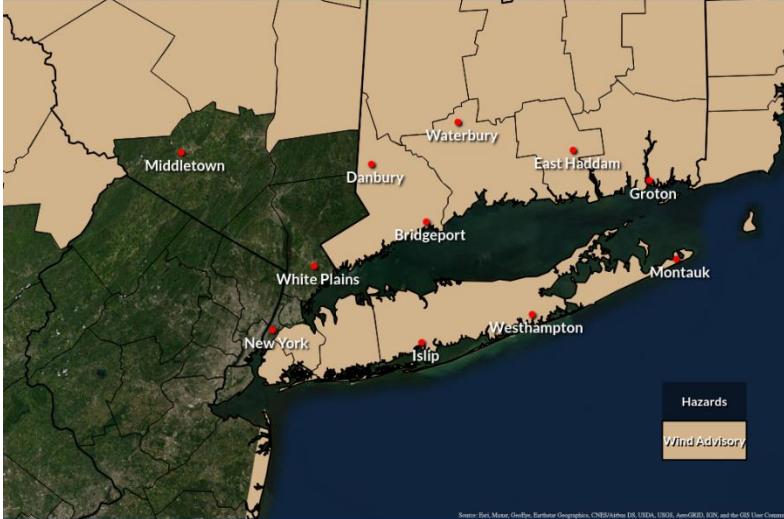
