Light Snow and Ice Potential Tonight into Tuesday



OVERVIEW

 An area of low pressure tracks along the East Coast through Tuesday, bringing a light snowfall and potential for a glaze of ice to the region.



NYC/NJ metro, Long Island, coastal and SW CT – Snow to Rain/Freezing Drizzle

Light snow develops this evening, continuing overnight before potentially tapering as freezing drizzle or light rain mid to late Tuesday morning.

Total Snowfall: 1 to 3 inches. This may result in hazardous/difficult travel for the Tuesday AM commute.

- Snowfall Rates: Up to 0.5 inch/hour
- Snowfall Character: Initially powdery, becoming wet and heavy

• **Temperatures:** Upper 20s tonight, rising into the mid 30s Tuesday PM. **Ice Accretion:** Glaze of ice accretion possible Tuesday morning on untreated and elevated surfaces.

Interior NE NJ, Lower Hudson Valley, interior SE CT – Snow

Light snow develops this evening, falling into Tuesday afternoon. **Total Snowfall**: 2 to 3 inches. This may result in hazardous/difficult travel for the Tuesday AM commute.

- Snowfall Rates: Up to 0.5 inch/hour
- Snowfall Character: Dry and powdery
- Temperatures: Low to mid 20s tonight, rising to near 30 Tuesday PM.



Most Likely Snowfall Accumulation – Official Forecast




