- * LOCATIONS...THE LOWER HUDSON VALLEY...NORTHEAST NEW JERSEY...NEW
YORK CITY...AND SOUTHWEST CONNECTICUT.
- * HAZARD TYPES...HEAVY SNOW AND NEAR BLIZZARD CONDITIONS.
- * ACCUMULATIONS...SNOW ACCUMULATION OF 10 TO 14 INCHES.
- * WINDS...NORTH 15 TO 25 MPH WITH GUSTS UP TO 35 MPH.
- * VISIBILITIES...ONE QUARTER MILE OR LESS AT TIMES.
- * TIMING...HEAVIEST SNOW AND STRONGEST WINDS WILL OCCUR OVERNIGHT
MONDAY INTO TUESDAY.
- * IMPACTS...BLOWING AND DRIFTING OF SNOW WITH NEAR BLIZZARD
CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED DUE TO STRONG WINDS.
