

## Riverhead Impacts

At 7.8 ft MLLW / 6.7 ft NGVD / 4.5 ft MHHW

Riverhead – (10/27/2018) 2-3 ft of inundation along the Peconic River waterfront [over River Street Park to Main Street](#). (moderate to major). Downtown areas near the river along [Heidi Behr Way](#) were inundated with 2 to 3 ft of water. Cars parked along these back parking lots along the river/pier just were destroyed. [Peconic Avenue](#) became inundated about an hour after high tide, prompting Riverhead Police to close the road, setting up barricades at Peconic Avenue and East Main Street.

Due to the astronomically high tides coming off the October 24th full moon, and generally 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 ft of surge from Easterly Gale to Storm force winds Friday Night into Saturday afternoon

Southampton- (12/17/2020) Localized minor flooding on [Shrubland Road](#), [Cold Spring Road](#), and [Cold Spring Point Road](#). Areas adjacent to Great Peconic Bay and Cold Spring Pond.


Hampton Bays – (12/17/2020) Localized minor flooding [on Red Creek Road between Hildreth Road and Upper Red Creek Road](#), [Wild Duck Lane](#), [Robins Nest Lane](#), [North Shore](#) and [Red Cedar Point Road](#). Areas adjacent to Great Peconic Bay.

Flanders- (12/17/2020) Minor tidal flooding in the areas of [Long Neck Blvd North of and including Pine Road and Fantasy Drive](#), [North end of Royal Ave](#), and [North end of Bay Avenue in the area of 89 and 92 Bay Ave](#). Areas adjacent to Reeves Bay.

**N winds 35g40mph**

**At 6.0 ft MLLW / 4.9 ft NGVD / 2.7 ft MHHW**

Riverhead - Nearly the entire stretch of [Heidi Behr Way on the town's Peconic River waterfront](#) was under nearly a foot of water just before high tide at about 9 p.m. Police barricades closed off most of the roadway as high winds and surge from the river cascaded over the road and formed a small lake in an adjacent parking lot. Mattituck- ½ to 1 ft or inundation along lowest lying creeksides. (3/6/2013)
