OVERVIEW

- Rain showers producing heavy downpours are possible as a slow moving frontal system passes though the region into Tuesday.
- There is a Slight Risk of Flash Flooding for the entire area both today and Tuesday.



- Storm Total Rainfall: 2 to 4 inches; locally higher amounts possible.
- Rainfall Rates: 0.5 to 1 "/hr.
- Impacts: Localized/Scattered flash flooding of urban areas, roads, and along small streams and creeks is likely. Flooding along larger streams and rivers and is unlikely at this time due to dry antecedent conditions.

TIMING & LOCATION

■ This afternoon through Tuesday evening. The heaviest rainfall is expected from this evening through midday Tuesday.

 Areas north and west of NYC and southern CT are expected to receive the heaviest rainfall.

NWS ALERTS

• **Flood Watch**: In effect starting this afternoon through Tuesday afternoon.

FORECAST

- There is moderate confidence in heavy rain showers and a few embedded thunderstorms developing, but it is uncertain how widespread the threat for flash flooding will be.
- Lower confidence in rainfall amounts over NE NJ, NYC, and Long Island with uncertainty in the exact position of frontal boundary.

■ By 6AM Tuesday unless significant forecast changes occur.



Excessive Rainfall/Flash Flood Outlook


