Several reports of nickel-sized hail were received, but the more significant damage occurred as a result of severe thunderstorm winds.

Wind damage was reported in Woodward in Woodward County, northeast of Avard in Woods County, in Kingfisher in Kingfisher County, in Stillwater in Payne County, in Ponca City in Kay County, in Norman in Cleveland County, and in Oklahoma City in Oklahoma County. The strongest measured wind speed was clocked at 64 mph in Woodward in Woodward County.

The largest hail fell in Dickson in Carter County, where hail as large as golf balls was reported. The strongest winds were estimated at 80 mph in Wynnewood in Garvin County, where at least one tree was downed.

Structural and tree damage due to severe thunderstorm winds was reported in Purcell and from Purcell to Dibble in McClain County and in Pauls Valley in Garvin County. Other more minor wind damage was reported in Kingfisher in Kingfisher County, near Concho in Canadian County, in Shawnee in Pottawatomie County, and west of Lamar in Hughes County.
