A brief tornado developed on the east side of Tonkawa. The most significant damage occurred to an open air carport that was destroyed and thrown 200 yards from the residence it was attached to. Other minor damage was reported to trees and a couple of roofs. Monetary damages were unavailable.

A prolonged area of southwest flow developed over much of Oklahoma during the period from the 10th through the 12th. Numerous disturbances moving through the flow allowed for widespread showers and thunderstorms to develop and move northeast over the area. Also, moisture associated with remnant Tropical Storm Lowell moved over western and northern Oklahoma. Although winds at most locations were nearly calm during the event, enough wind shear was in place for very small, short-lived circulations to develop. Two areas of damage were reported with brief tornadoes, one near the Clinton airport in Custer county, and the other in Tonkawa in Kay county. The damage was relatively minor, with tree and roof damage reported. Several chickens were killed when their chicken coop was destroyed. Monetary damages were estimated.

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
