

### VI.3.3B-SYSTEM-CPUTIME PROGRAM PPINIT COMMAND CPUTIME

#### Purpose

Command CPUTIME prints the total CPU time used and the CPU time used since the command was last executed.

If the CPUTIME output unit option has been specified with the @SETUNT command and the @CPUTIME command is specified, the CPU time used by each command will be printed to both the specified unit and the normal print unit.

#### Format

@CPUTIME  $\left( \begin{array}{l} \text{AUTO}^\circ \\ \text{NO} \\ \text{YES} \\ \text{RESET} \end{array} \right)$

#### Parameter Description

<u>Parameter</u>	<u>Required/ Optional</u>	<u>Maximum Characters</u>	<u>Description</u>
AUTO	0		CPU time used will be printed automatically after each command is completed
NO	0		Turns off CPU timer
YES	0		Turns on CPU timer
RESET	0		Resets CPU timer to zero
