4.1.4 Session Log

ESPADP creates a log file in the espadp dir/output directory.

This file contains a list of status, warning and error messages. Also, status, warning and error messages are written to the lower half of the ESPTrace Manager in a scrollable window. Different levels of detail can be sent to the file and screen, respectively and can be controlled by ESPADP run time options. Level 1 run time warnings are also sent to the user interface via a pop-up dialog.

Options

See command options for running ESPADP, Section 3.2.

User Notes

Because default settings point to potentially common workspace, the *espadp.log* file will be overwritten if it exists in *espts_dir/output*. It is suggested that the user set up *espadp_dir* to point input and output directories to ESPADP.
