

B-3. Miscellaneous

- Raid-5 allows for a single drive to fail at any given time without any data loss. In a multiple disk failure situation, data will be lost, thus the importance of still having a backup strategy.
- NFS mount “/awips/hydroapps/lx” has been changed to “awips/hydroapps” in release ob7.2. This will provide access to commands located in /awips/hydroapps/lx/public/bin, access to the geo_data directory, and so on.
- In addition, RFCs will no longer have to maintain a second set of .Apps_defaults and .Apps_defaults_site files on the RAX.
- An RFC can choose to have the RAX’s shefdecoders use the IHFS shefdecoder’s SHEFPARM file instead of maintaining a duplicate on the RAX.
- Postgres creates the database within the Linux files system.
- The data feed from the SBN will require localization of the acq_patterns.txt file.
