1.0 General Information

1.1 Description

The cron_Pgbkups application is a Korn script. The script uses the Postgres command pg_dump along with the Linux gzip command to create a backup of the RFC Archive DB. This script can be run in the cron or at the command line. A separate script called run_PGbkups is provided which has more output options (see section M-1); it is run at the command line. Output files created by the cron_PGbkups script are written to the /data/dbbackups directory.

1.2 Enhancements/Bug Fixes/Changes

Build OB7.2

This application is new to this build and replaces the Informix level-0 archive script.

2.0 Cron Info

Sample entry for oper's cron is shown below:

15 6 *** /rfc_arc/scripts/dbadmin/cron_Pgbkups > /rfc_arc/logs/dbadmin/cronBU.log 2>> /rfc_arc/logs/dbadmin/cronBU.log

For a database of approximately 15gb, the pg_dump command will take about an hour and a half to run.
