March 8, 2009 Tornadoes

On March 8, 2009 a supercell tracked east along the Western Kentucky Parkway and was responsible for all of the severe weather events except a brief tornado in Webster County. Six tornado tracks were identified from the March 8 storms, and all tornadoes were rated EF-2 or lower.
