# Harrisburg EF-4 Tornado February 29, 2012

A line of severe thunderstorms produced damage across parts of southeast Missouri, southern Illinois, southwest Indiana, and western Kentucky during the early morning hours Wednesday. Several tornadoes touched down across the WFO Paducah forecast area. At least 7 fatalities and dozens of injuries occurred with the early morning storms, with the southern Illinois community of Harrisburg the hardest hit area.



IN RIDGWAY...THE TORNADO DAMAGED ABOUT 140 HOMES AND BUSINESSES CAUSING 1 CRITICAL INJURY AND ABOUT A DOZEN RELATIVELY MINOR INJURIES. NUMEROUS CARS WERE TOSSED AROUND...MAINLY ON THE EAST SIDE RIDGWAY. A LARGE CHURCH BUILDING WAS COMPLETELY DESTROYED. A HALF DOZEN GRAIN BINS WERE COMPLETELY DESTROYED.




