SUMMARY: THE BROAD AREA OF SCATTERED WIND DAMAGE CONSISTING MOSTLY OF DOWNED TREE LIMBS AVERAGING 3 TO 6 INCHES IN DIAMETER...WITH OCCASIONAL UPROOTED TREES...GENERALLY SMALL IN SIZE. TIN ROOFING WAS PEELED PARTIALLY OFF OF A FEW OUTBUILDINGS OR BARNES AND ONE SMALL GARAGE HAD ITS ENTIRE ROOF BLOWN OFF ON ISOM ROAD IN CHRISTIAN COUNTY. IN HOPKINS COUNTY...AT LEAST 10 TREES WERE UPROOTED. IN TODD COUNTY...THERE WERE A FEW BARNES WITH MINOR ROOF DAMAGE (TIN ROOF PEELING BACKWARDS). THREE MACHINE TYPE SHEDS A COUPLE 100 FEET IN LENGTH HAD A THIRD OF THEIR ROOFING BLOWN OFF.

SURVEY SUMMARY: TORNADO MOVED ALONG HWY 109 FROM THE EAST EDGE OF STURGIS TO NEAR POPLAR RIDGE ROAD. MAINLY TREES WERE DAMAGED ALONG THE PATH WITH SEVERAL SNAPPED OR UPROOTED. THERE WAS MINOR DAMAGE TO A COUPLE OF HOMES WITH SOFFIT AND SHINGLE DAMAGE. TWO OUTBUILDINGS WERE DESTROYED...ONE THROWN ABOUT 75 YARDS INTO A GROUP OF TREES.

SURVEY SUMMARY: TORNADO MOVED THROUGH A PARTIALLY WOODED AREA WITH SEVERAL TREES SNAPPED OR UPROOTED. ONE BARN WAS DAMAGED.

NOTE: THERE WERE SEVERAL ISOLATED POCKETS OF STRAIGHT LINE WIND DAMAGE ACROSS SOUTHERN UNION COUNTY INTO NORTHER WEBSTER COUNTY. THE MOST SIGNIFICANT OF WHICH WAS AT THE UNION COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS WHERE ONE BARN WAS DAMAGED AND DEBRIS DAMAGED 2 CAMPERS. MOST OF THE OTHER DAMAGE WAS TO TREES IN THE AREA. PEAK WINDS WERE NEAR 95 MPH.
