

DOZENS OF VEHICLES WERE DAMAGED DUE TO FALLEN TREES. THOUSANDS OF TREES WERE UPROOTED...SNAPPED OR OTHERWISE DAMAGED.

HUNDREDS OF POWER POLES WERE SNAPPED OR BLOWN OVER. DAMAGE TO ONE FARMSTEAD WAS ESTIMATED AT OVER 2 MILLION DOLLARS

...AND THE TOTAL DAMAGE ESTIMATES MAY EXCEED 100 MILLION.
