...BLIZZARD CONFIRMED ON NEW JERSEY COAST AND DELAWARE BEACHES...

The National Weather Service in Mount Holly, New Jersey can confirm that blizzard criteria was met last night and this morning along the coastal strip of New Jersey and along the Delaware Beaches. This includes areas such as the Monmouth County coast, Long Beach Island, Atlantic City, Cape May, and all of the Delaware Beaches. A blizzard is defined as three or more hours of visibility reductions to one quarter mile or less due to falling or blowing snow, and sustained winds or frequent gusts of 35 mph or greater.

Further analysis will be conducted in the days ahead to determine which additional inland zones, if any, reached blizzard criteria during this event. Further analysis will also be conducted to determine the exact start and end times of blizzard conditions in the areas where such conditions have already been confirmed.
