- Even with abundant moisture and rainfall, temperatures were still above normal.

## Monsoon Stats

- Monsoon season runs from June 15th - September 30th.
- 30 - 60% of annual rainfall comes during monsoon season.
- Flash floods, lightning, microbursts, dust storms, and heat waves are common hazards.

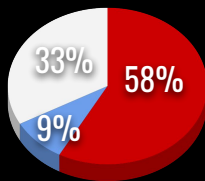
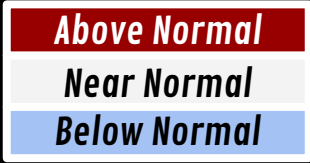

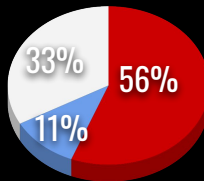

## Temperature Outlook

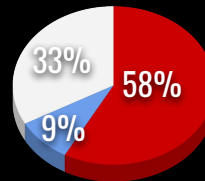
Above normal temperatures are favored statewide. Remember, excessive heat is the number one weather related killer in the US!



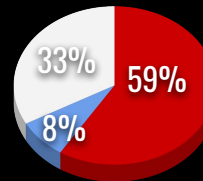

## Precipitation Outlook

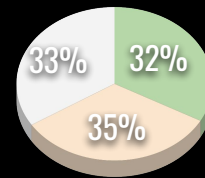
Equal chances for above, below, or average monsoon rainfall is forecast, with a slight tilt towards drier than normal in eastern and central Arizona



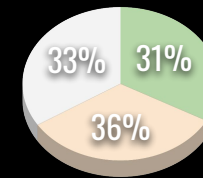

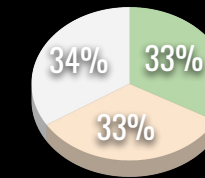
