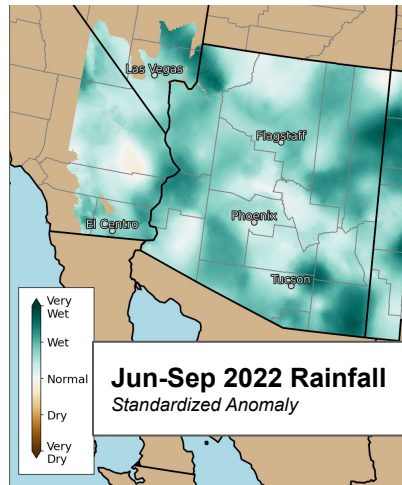


2022 Monsoon Recap

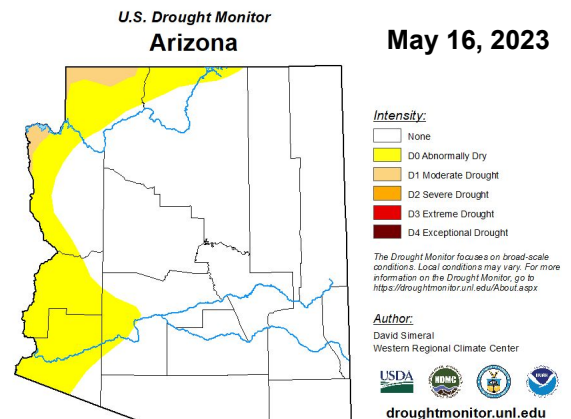
Arizona had a very wet 2022 monsoon. Most of the state saw well above normal rainfall. This monsoon tied for the 7th wettest July-September on record.

Phoenix: 2.23"

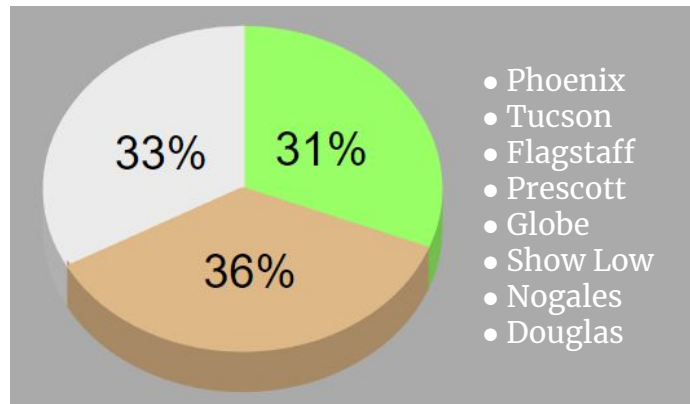


Current Drought Status

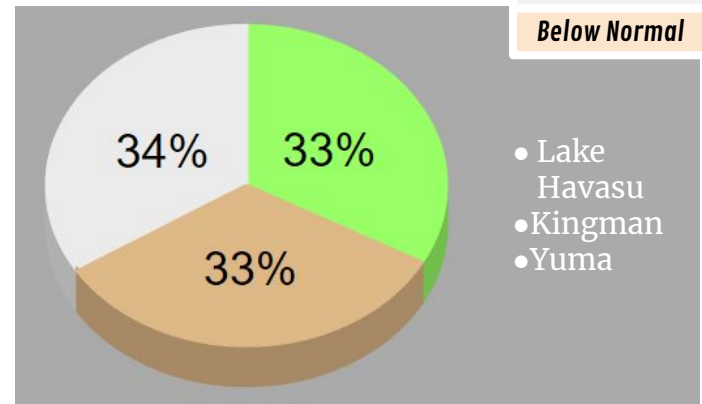


2023 Monsoon Outlook

Eastern & Central AZ: Lean Below Normal



Far Western AZ: Equal Chances



There is a slight tilt in odds toward a drier than normal monsoon across eastern and central Arizona. The remainder of the state will see equal chances for above, near, or below normal precipitation. Warmer than normal temperatures are favored for all of Arizona.
