New State High Temperature Record at John Martin Dam – 115° Fahrenheit

The National Weather Service in Pueblo, Colorado, the Colorado Climate Center, and the National Center for Environmental Information have determined that a new State of Colorado record for maximum temperature was set at John Martin Dam on July 20, 2019.

On Saturday, July 20, 2019 a maximum temperature of 115° Fahrenheit was recorded at John Martin Dam by a group of National Weather Service Cooperative Observers. The previous State of Colorado record was 114° Fahrenheit set on July 1, 1933 in Las Animas, CO and then tied on July 11, 1954 at Sedgwick, CO.
