In addition, wind gusts in the I-25 corridor included 61 to 63 mph around the Air Force Academy (El Paso County)...62 mph around Pueblo (Pueblo County) and near Peterson Air Force Base (El Paso County)...and 68 mph 9 miles north-northwest of Walsenburg.
