






## JANUARY 2008: Dry, Mild with Subnormal Snowfall Across the Washington/Baltimore Area



## **January Highlights**

- Well above normal temperatures across the area with departures +5.1°F at DCA, 3.1°F at BWI and 3.8°F at IAD
- Record highs of 73°F at DCA, and 70°F at BWI and IAD on 8th
- Max readings more than 20°F above normal from 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> with highs from the upper 60s to lower 70s
- Only 1 day with subfreezing highs at DCA (21st); 2 such days at BWI and IAD
- Wind chill readings as low as 6°F at IAD on 20th as gusty winds accompany readings in the 30s
- ₹ Fifth driest January on record at IAD, 9th driest at DCA, 12th driest at Baltimore
- Months' only significant snowfall occurs on 17<sup>th</sup> with amounts up to 6" in some locations impacting travel and transportation
- Subnormal snowfall at DCA for January with 1.3"
- Below normal snowfall at DCA for 8 of last 10 years.
