


Wet & Unsettled Early Next Week

Rich moisture from the Gulf and Atlantic will lift northward across the Southeast US. and Sunday, with a potentially wet period of weather for the first half of next week. 2 to 4 inches of total rainfall are possible across central NC through the middle of next week.



Outlooks for Monday and Tuesday, May 12-13, 2025




Key Messages: There is a Slight Risk of excessive rainfall for central NC to start the week. Periods of moderate to heavy rainfall are expected early Monday through Tuesday night. Total rainfall amounts through Tuesday night of 2 to 4 inches are expected, with isolated higher totals to near 5 inches possible.


