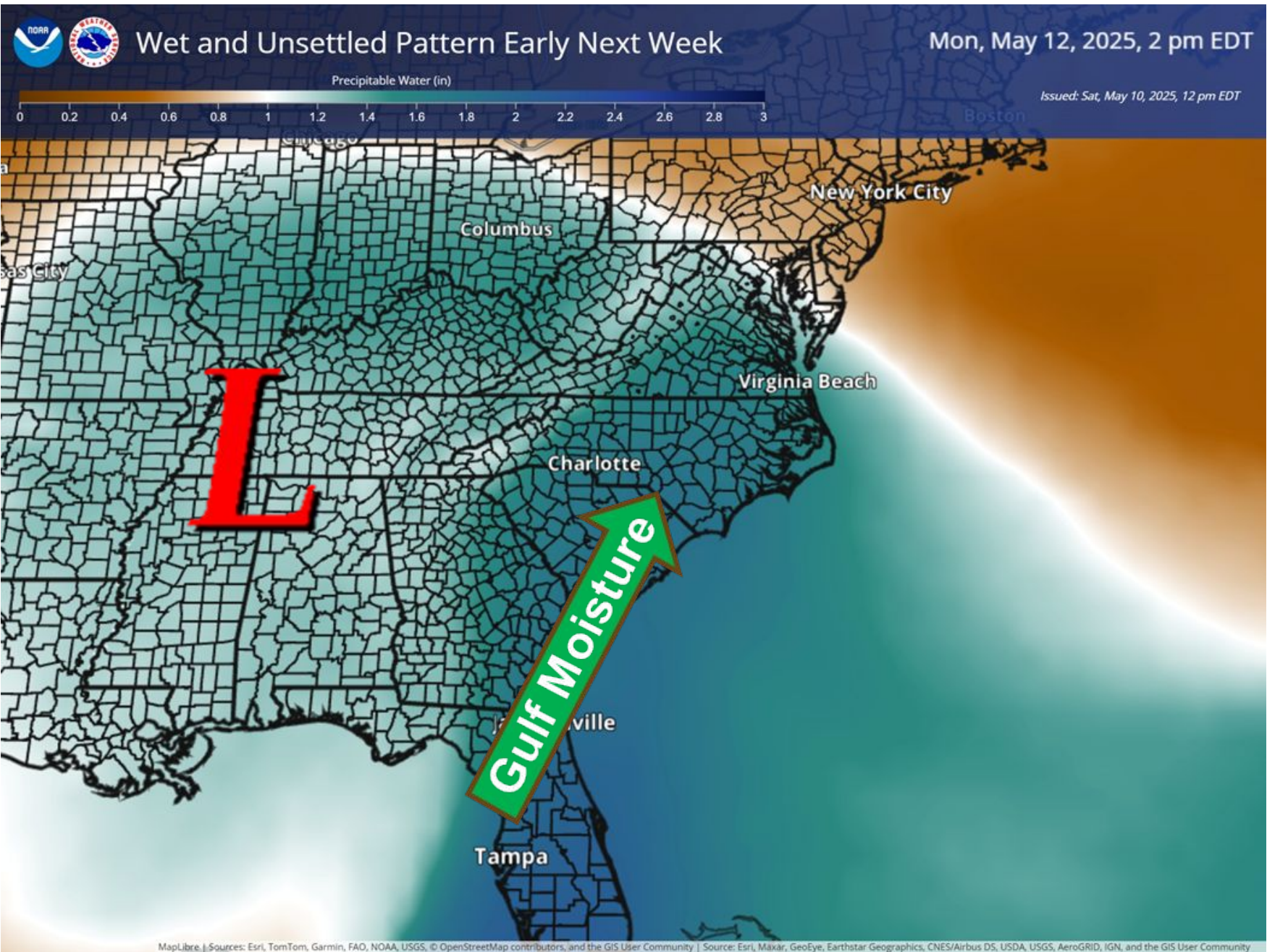




Wet & Unsettled Early Next Week

Outlook for Through Wednesday, May 14, 2025



Rich moisture from the Gulf and Atlantic will lift northward across the Southeast US. Clouds and rain chances will increase tonight and Sunday, with a potentially wet period of weather for the first half of next week. 2 to 4 inches of total rainfall are possible across central NC through the middle of next week.

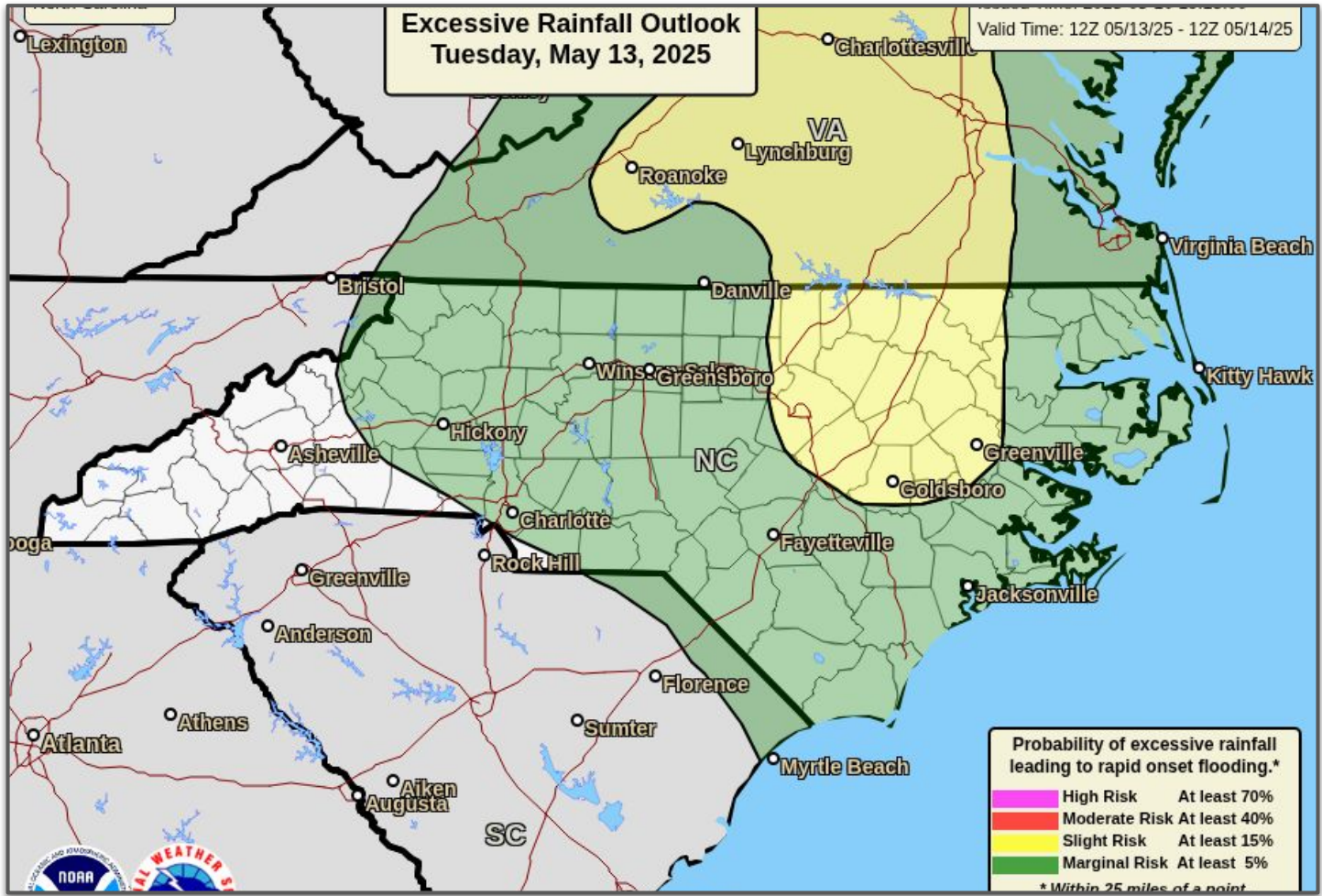
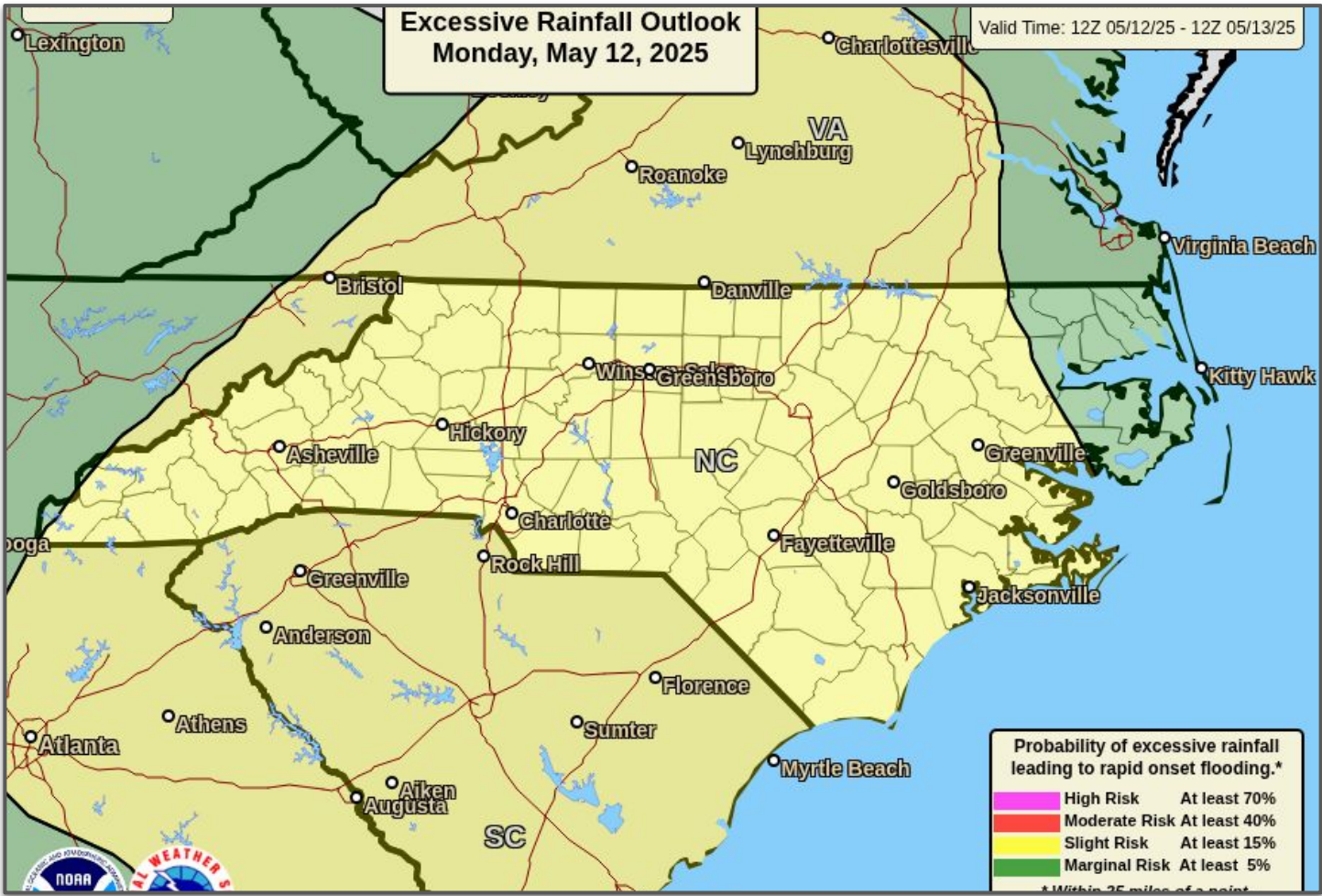






Slight Risk of Excessive Rainfall

Outlooks for Monday and Tuesday, May 12-13, 2025





Key Messages: There is a Slight Risk of excessive rainfall for central NC to start the week. Periods of moderate to heavy rainfall are expected early Monday through Tuesday night. Total rainfall amounts through Tuesday night of 2 to 4 inches are expected, with isolated higher totals to near 5 inches possible.

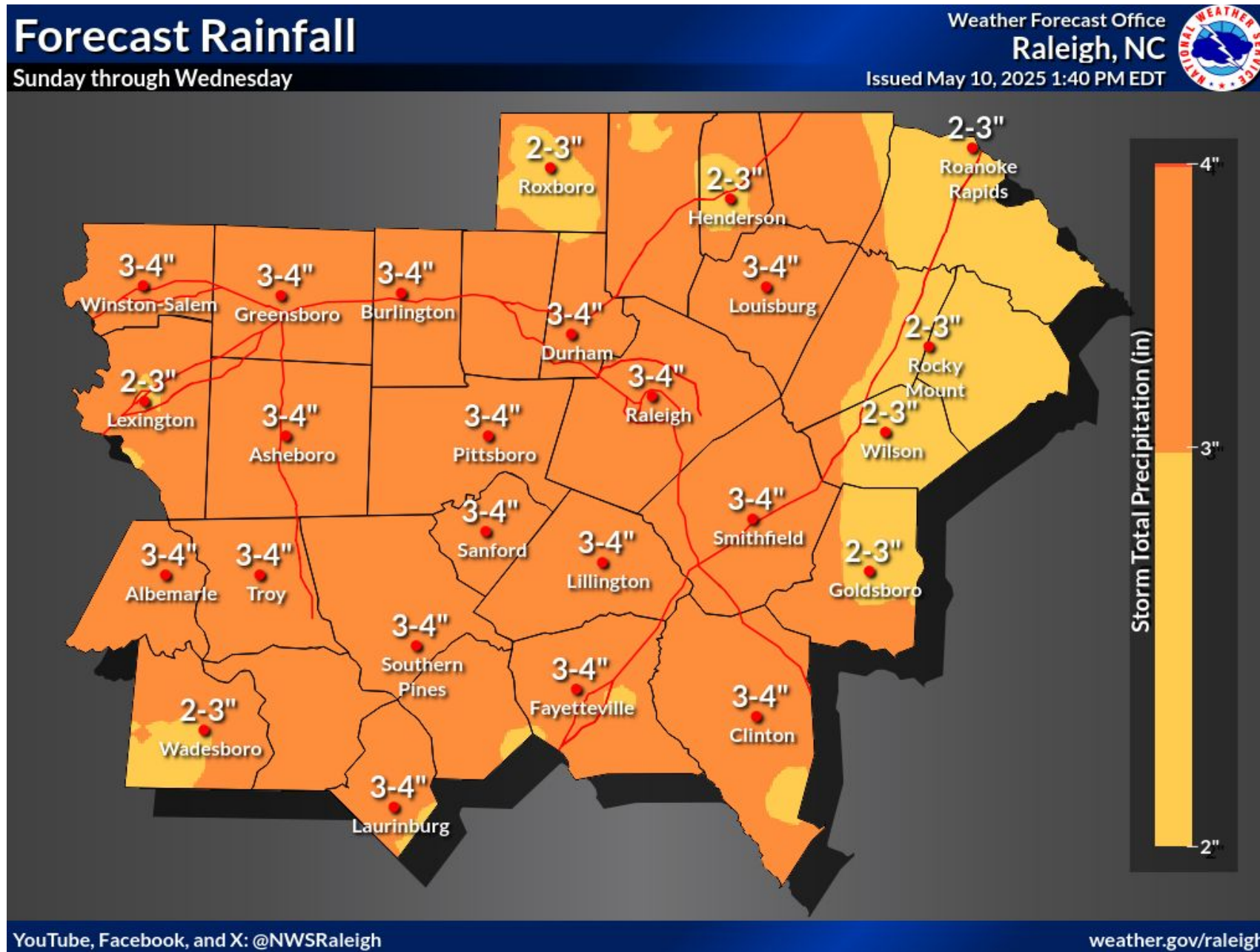

- Rainfall totals of 2 to 4 inches are expected across Central NC, the majority of which will fall Monday and Tuesday
- Isolated higher totals upwards of 5 inches will also be possible
- Minor river flooding, as well as localized flash flooding, are the main hazards Monday through Wednesday.
