



Breezy Today; Warm Trend Continues through Next Week

Good morning! Warm and dry conditions are the theme for this weekend and early next week. Near record highs are likely starting from Sunday to Tuesday. Chances for showers and thunderstorms return by Tuesday afternoon in the Sierra. - Hector

KEY POINTS

- Increasing winds this afternoon north of I-80
- Warming-up continues this weekend, reaching near record temps early next week
- Low chances for showers and thunderstorms return by mid-week

CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

- Reno could see its first 90°F day Sunday or Monday, with South Lake Tahoe potentially hitting its first 80°F day Monday.
