It was a hot and very humid July across the NWS Charleston forecast area. Mean temperatures for the month generally ranged between 2 to 5 degrees above normal, with 5 of 6 climate sites making the top 10 in terms of their warmest average temperature on record for July. Precipitation totals across the forecast area varied rather significantly, with some locations well below normal, while others were well above normal. Both Clarksburg and Huntington made their top 10 in terms of wettest on record.
