Summary: The San Juan ASOS reported 1.78 inches of rain for the month of January; 1.98 less than the normal of 3.76 inches. The ASOS rainfall report from Cyril E. King Airport in St. Thomas was 0.55 inches for the month of January; 1.83 inches less than the normal of 2.38 inches.
