


Florida Severe Weather Network (FSWN)

FDEM WeatherSTEM Units Installed or Planned As of 4/29





WeatherSTEM FSWN Phase III

- Phase 3 appropriation granted for FY22 (July 1, 2021 June 30, 2022)
- 50 stations
 - 3 Year Maintenance Contract with each station
- Installation Requirements:
 - MOA from recipient (county or city) agreeing to Operations and Maintenance Costs years 4-10
 - Access to site property for installation and maintenance
- Site Selection
 - Government-owned property preferred
 - Areas of sparse existing weather monitoring
