The National Weather Service in Tallahassee is offering the opportunity to work with forecasters in an operational environment **virtually** with the NWS Weather Forecast Office in Tallahassee in Fall 2022.

Minimum Qualifications:

Currently enrolled at an University in pursuit of a meteorology degree (Freshmen class and above) or a graduate student in meteorology.

Application Process and Deadlines:

Your application should include the following:

- * A one page resume
- * A cover letter – up to one page
- * An unofficial transcript
- * Two essays (each limited to one page, unless specified otherwise)

1. Why does a career in operational meteorology interest you?
2. What do you feel is your greatest strength, and how do you think it will help you succeed in this volunteer position with NWS Tallahassee?

Applications are due by **email** to both (eric.bunker@noaa.gov and kelly.godsey@noaa.gov) no later than **3 pm on Friday, July 22nd**

Interviews will be held on **August 8th through August 17th Virtually via Google Hangout**. Selections will be made by **September 1st**. Volunteer work will begin virtually in early September (around the beginning of the Fall Semester).
