

April 2022 Climate Summary for West Central and Southwest Florida

Temperatures averaged near to a few degrees above normal for this month with a few sites ending up in the Top Ten Warmest for April.

As far as rainfall, April is usually one of the drier months of the year, and in some parts of the area this was true. However, we did see a couple of cold fronts early in the month that brought widespread showers and thunderstorms to areas from around Interstate 4 northward. Then during the last few days of April, a more summer-like pattern setup with afternoon and evening sea breeze thunderstorms pushing some locations well above normal for the month.
