Use Layer Function to display more Forecast Information

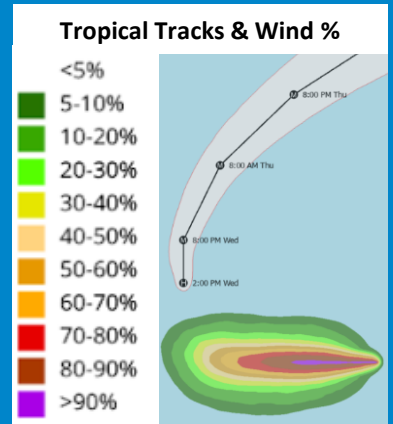

**ACT FAST**

- Move to a cooler area
- Loosen clothing
- Sip cool water
- Seek medical help if symptoms don't improve

Dizziness, Thirst, Heavy Sweating, Nausea, Weakness

**ACT FAST**

**CALL 911**

- Move person to a cooler area
- Loosen clothing and remove extra layers
- Cool with water or ice

Heat exhaustion can lead to heat stroke.      Heat stroke can cause death or permanent disability if emergency treatment is not given.

**Don't underestimate the power of water!**

- 6 inches of fast-moving water can knock over and carry away an adult.
- 12 inches of fast-moving water can carry away a small car.
- 18-24 inches of fast-moving water can carry away most large SUVs, vans and trucks.
