Precipitation

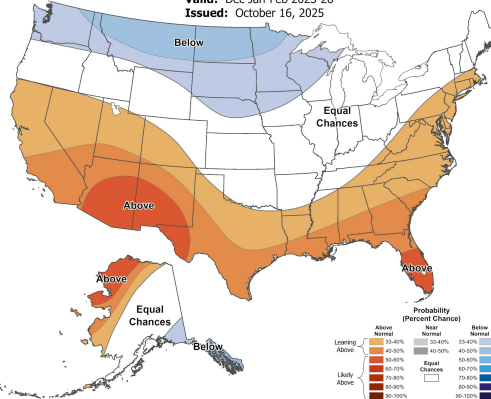
Impacts from a **drier** and **warmer**
than normal winter:

- Continued/worsening drought
- Reductions in water supply
- Earlier start to the Spring wildfire season



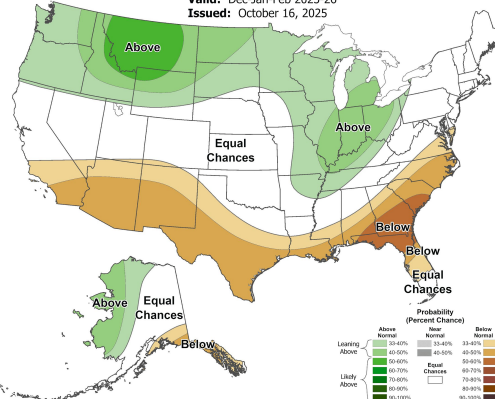
Seasonal Temperature Outlook

Favored Wintertime Effects in Southeast AZ

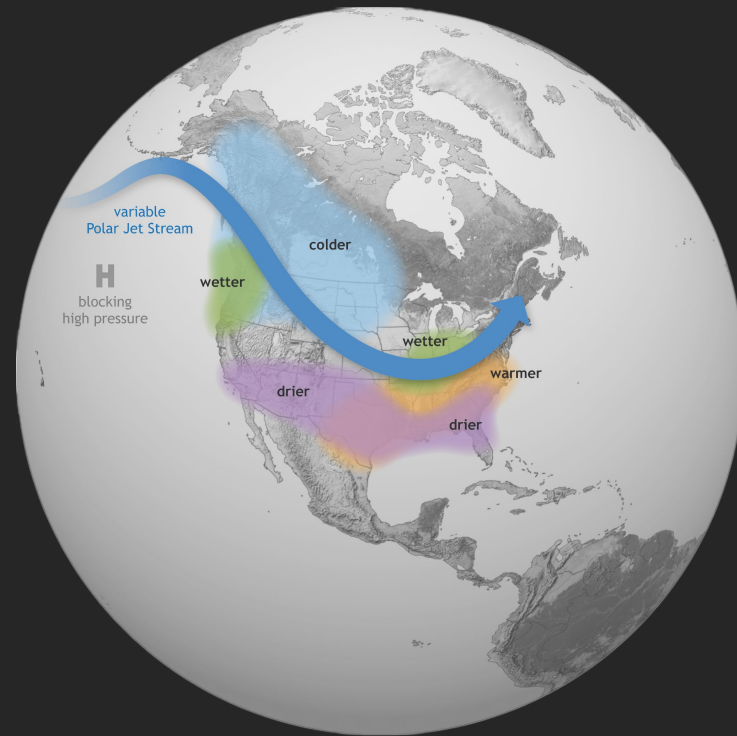
⚠ No two years are alike

Drier than average

Warmer than average

Weak La Niña conditions are favored to continue into winter, with a transition to ENSO neutral likely by early spring.

Weak La Niña conditions are less likely to result in typical La Niña impacts.



*Typical **La Niña** deviations from average*



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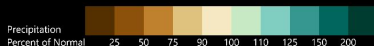
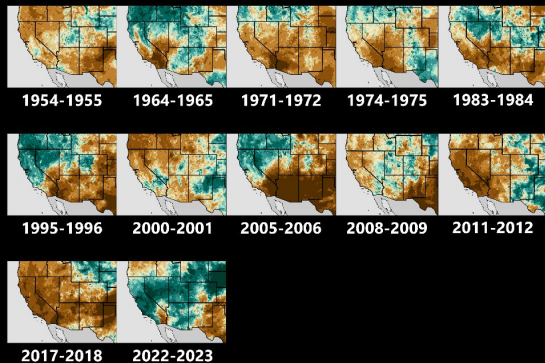

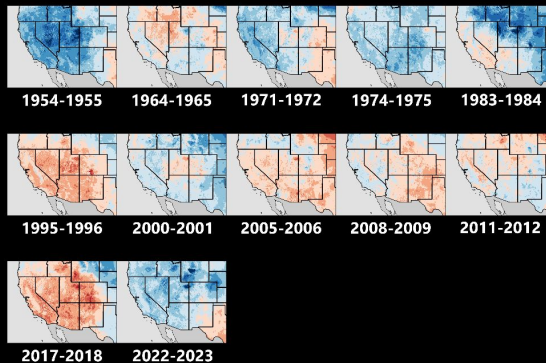
