Synopsis / Forecast Discussion:

Surface low pressure moving east-northeast along a cold frontal boundary, will pass just south of the Cape Cod area Friday and Friday night, producing IFR conditions in showers and fog with strong NNE winds. High pressure will build across the local area Saturday through Monday, resulting in generally fair and mainly dry conditions but maintaining moderate to strong NE winds. Please note: This will be the last scheduled Cape weekend outlook/forecast issued until May 2021, unless requested by the FAA to issue one for a specific weekend.
