#### PROB30 in the first 9 hours of the TAF



#### Why?

- ➤ NWS can better address inconsistencies between its public and aviation products. Adding PROB30 in the first 9 hours of the TAF allows NWS to take advantage of the probability of precipitation NDFD grid.
- Better alignment at the Command Center with Airline TAFs that use PROB in the first 9 hours.
- > When? NWS training and software adjustment needed. Targeting Spring 2024.



## Reduction of VC usage



- With PROB30 allowed in the first 9 hours, we can minimize or in some cases eliminate the use of VCTS
- ➤ International definition for VC is "between approximately 5 and 10SM of the aerodrome reference point and used only in <u>METAR and SPECI with present</u> <u>weather.</u>" This inclusion of VC likely was introduced in 1995 when US transitioned for the AIRWAYS (SA) code to METAR
- NWS forecasters use it as a hedge to introduce the possibility of Convection in the first 9 hours since PROB30 was not allowed



### Reduction of VC usage



- ➤ Usage of VCTS is inconsistent between offices and forecasters. Some offices use it to convey convection near a TRACON, some use it for different distances, and for areas with complex terrain.
- Frustrating to the airlines...whats VC really mean at Philly, New York, Dallas, Bismarck, Salt Lake City? We're all over the place....
- > Try AFD etc
- > Training and best practices being developed
- ➤ 10-813 TAF Directive being revised
